CAPITAL CITY CORVETTE CLUB GENERAL MEETING MAY 7, 2008

President John Bechtel called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Patty & Mark Lewis from Grand Ledge are visiting.

Secretary: Sandy Bechtel presented the minutes of the April 2, 2008 general meeting. Gary Wyma moved to approve the minutes as presented. Mike Britz seconded. Motion approved.

Ambassador: Sandy Bechtel advised construction on the museum's expansion has begun. You can go on line at <u>www.corvettemuseum.com/webcam</u> to see the progress. Also, the museum has a new brick program for the walkway to be paved in front of the addition. Sandy introduced Joe Thomas, Michigan captain for the 2009 caravan. Joe noted our caravan will be leaving from Lansing on September 2, 2009. It will merge with Indiana's caravan on September 3, 2009, and continue to the museum that day. A DVD was shown to help explain the caravan.

Points: Carrie Hutton advised current point totals are posted on our website. She reminded people to use sign-up sheets for meetings and events. John Bechtel explained we are coordinating event participation with our waiver forms. Carrie offered club window stickers (\$3.00) and banners (\$5.00) for sale.

Membership: Colleen Bratschi advised we currently have 109 regular, 1 honorary, and 72 Future Corvette Owners of America (FCOA) members. Colleen offered club flags (\$15.00) and shirts (\$8.00) for sale. She also explained that the NCCC membership year runs from August 1st to July 31st. If a person joins after July 31st, he/she will not have to pay an NCCC renewal fee on November 1st (our club's membership renewal date).

Social: Kathy Wyma referred us to our website for event fliers. *On May 26th, we will meet at 8:00 a.m. at the Coyote Grill and caravan to Marshall for their Memorial Day parade. Carmichaels have again invited our club to join them for a hog roast following the parade. *We will meet at1:15 p.m. at the West Saginaw Quality Dairy (near Art Van) for the May 31st drive & dine. *If you plan to attend our June 6-8 spring fling in Traverse City, make your room reservations now (see Bob Maynard for details). *Our June drive & dine has been re-scheduled for June 29th. We will meet at 2:30 p.m. in the Okemos Meijer parking lot. *Keep August 2nd open for a drive & dine to Turkeyville for a dinner theatre evening. *Colleen Bratschi noted it is time to begin signing up for our July 30th mini-golf outing at Hawk Hollow. *Simon Reiffer advised it is necessary to make your room reservations immediately if you plan to attend Corvette Crossroads in late August. *John Bechtel noted the Battle Creek Corvette Club is celebrating their 20th anniversary on May 18th.

Treasurer: Carol Putmon advised she has all account information available for review.

Governor/Vice President: Rich Bratschi indicated sanction fee changes were voted down at the recent NCCC regional meeting. NCCC is entertaining a dues increase for 2009. Our region is not supporting the increase. (Gloria Reiffer noted the last increase was absorbed by our club.) Rich encouraged everyone to attend our August 16th low-speed event, and to work and race.

President: *John Bechtel encouraged members to attend the Pure Stock Muscle Car Drag races in Stanton, MI on September 12-13. *John noted IntelliChoice voted the Corvette as the best value for vehicles costing \$24,000 or more. *John advised it is necessary to purchase insurance for our new trailer (liability and physical damage), as well as coverage for our personal property (DJ equipment, canopies, tables, etc.). Because there is almost no market for such coverage for a club like ours that does not own a vehicle to tow the trailer, we have only been able to secure one quote (Acquity) through Bob Maynard. John further explained that insurance premiums were not included in our 2008 operating budget. He requested that \$500.00 be withdrawn from our CD to pay for insurance. (Future budgets will include this expense.) Dave Kuempel moved to approve the \$500.00 withdrawal and expenditure. Carrie Hutton seconded. Motion passed.

New Business: None

Member Comment: Dave and Diana Kuempel stated they have already signed up for the 2009 Caravan, and encouraged others to join them.

Low Speed Driving School

Woo Whoo, what an experience! I would encourage every Vette owner to participate in a low speed driving school. I attended the Corvette Low Speed Driving School held Saturday, May 10, 2008 in Marshall, MI by Calhoun County Corvette Club.

The certificate I received after completing the training read: It is hoped that this experience will further your understanding, appreciation and enjoyment of driving your CORVETTE in actual competitive events in the future.

I have an *understanding* of what my car is capable of and how to handle it. I have an *appreciation* for the skills that I have acquired from the expertise of the instructors to the fine product the Corvette is. I have always had *enjoyment* for my car but taking it to the next level was awesome. Many of the skills learned in a legally controlled environment can be carried over into some driving situations on the public streets.

A few of the Capital City Corvette Club members were in attendance. As volunteers, they were greatly appreciated by Calhoun County Corvette Club members as they quickly put them to work around the course. I would like to thank John Bechtel, Gary Wyma, Milton Price, Dave Kuempel and Jim DeNike for their cheers and encouragement.

My first two times through the course was pretty slow. I heard that I looked something like Grandma driving her Buick to the grocery store....ha ha! The third time through I told my instructor to make sure his seat belt was tight because I had figured out the course. Each additional time through the course I felt a little bit more confident. There were 10 runs in the morning and 10 in the afternoon. The afternoon runs were timed with deductions for knocking cones out of their box. I kept giving myself a goal to obtain a better time each run. I enjoyed speeding around those cones so much, and that it made Jim pretty nervous as he wasn't sure what I would do if we encountered a construction zone with cones on the way home.

The weather was just a bit cool in the morning but was perfect by lunchtime when we were treated to grilled hot dogs, hamburgers, chips, salads, and cookies. As a volunteer you are given a free lunch for helping out. What a great opportunity for Vette owners. Food and Vette conversation, what could be better?

Once again....What a great experience! Everyone should "bond" with their car at least once, if not MANY times!

This recipe was sent to us by Bill Griffith, our club member down in Pearl River, Louisiana. Sounds good!

Try This....It is easy, and I do it all the time. Can't Fail!!!

Here's the recipe for the crawfish/shrimp/crab sauce. (I normally serve it over angel hair pasta)

1 Qt. Half and Half 1/2 lb. butter

1/2 cup flour

Angel Hair Pasta

1 or 2 tablespoons chopped green onion tops (more if you like'em)

1 1/2 tablespoons Worchestershire Sauce

2 pounds of crawfish tails , shrimp, or lump crab meat (or a combination)

(I usually boil them first in Zatarain's liquid crab boil) * they're after a "boil" and a party, and it's hard

to peel and save!....I like to peel and EAT!!!....but ya have to.

1 teaspoon black pepper

1 teaspoon salt

1 tablespoon LA HOT SAUCE (Don't use Tabasco...it's CRAP!...I hate Tabasco, it ain't Louisiana....it's all grown in Mexico, and S. America!...screw them!)

1 tablespoon of chopped garlic (minced from grocery store is OK...easier)

In a saucepan, heat the half and half. In another small pan, melt butter and add flour slowly. Whisk until flour is incorporated. Add the flour mix to the half and half and cook a little to thicken. (Don't boil or "scald")

Remove from heat. Cook Pasta....like directions say....I do it 4 minutes in a boil....aldente' or something like that. Drain Pasta.

Add rest of ingredients to cream sauce. Stir and heat.

Place Pasta on plates and ladle cream sauce over the pasta.

Garnish with parsley, green onions, and parmesan cheese if ya like to.

Enjoy.

French bread, and a nice salad go good with this.

*(It's also REAL GOOD ladled over grilled RedFish filets, or any "firm" fish that lends itself to grilling.)

I hope you try this and enjoy it.
