Electric Corvette

Electric vehicles don't have to be dull transportation. The **Genovation GXE** team has built an all-electric Corvette that has 800 hp and 700 lb-ft of torque. The GXE has an electric powertrain, and even more power than the new Corvette ZR1.

This vette is fun to drive and can hit 60 mph in less than three seconds and has a top speed of more than 220 mph. The GXE will come with an optional manual transmission if you don't want the paddle-shifted automatic. Whether you like electric cars or not, it's pretty awesome that you will be able to shift your own gears behind the wheel of an 800-hp Corvette.

There are two downsides to the Genovation GXE. The GXE has a range of 130 miles, since there is a limited amount of space for batteries in a sports car that was never designed to be made electric. And the price is \$750,000 for one of the 75 planned GXEs. They will however, offer bespoke paint and custom-tailored interior that will fit each customer's requirements.

We can walk into town for pancakes (or other food offerings) and still have time to visit the craft booths before heading back to our cars for the parade which starts at 3:00 p.m.

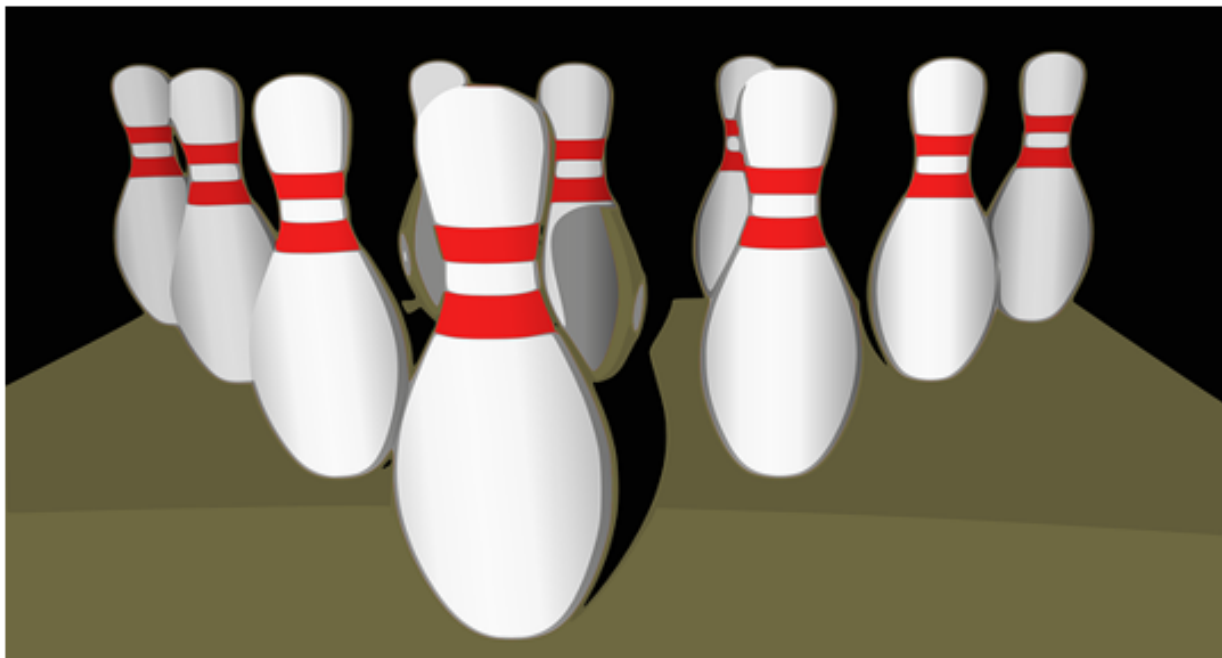
