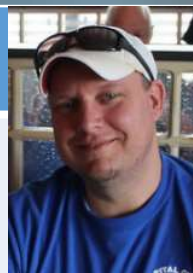

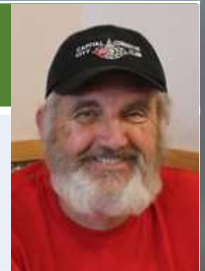

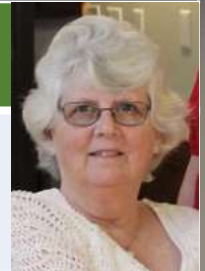

Message from the Governor




Due to health reasons, Jerry Wardell has stepped down as President of Capital City Corvette Club. Jerry sends his apologies to Membership and hopes for a smooth transition to a new leader.

Article IV of our By-Laws state that:

- Section B.2.a: President - Must have held a prior Elected Office in the Club.
- Section C.1: Vacancies - Any vacancies of Elected Officers before July 1 shall be filled by nomination and election by Membership. After July 1, such a vacancy shall be filled by appointment by the President and subject to approval by the majority of the Board of Directors. In the event of the President's office being vacated after July 1, the Governor shall assume the duties of the President for the remainder of the year.

Please submit nominations for this position to 4c.board@ccc Corvette.org, or call me at 517.646.2180, by February 1 so that those who are nominated may be contacted and a ballot made available for vote. We will try to have absentee ballots go out by mid-February and hope to have the election completed at the March 3 Membership meeting.

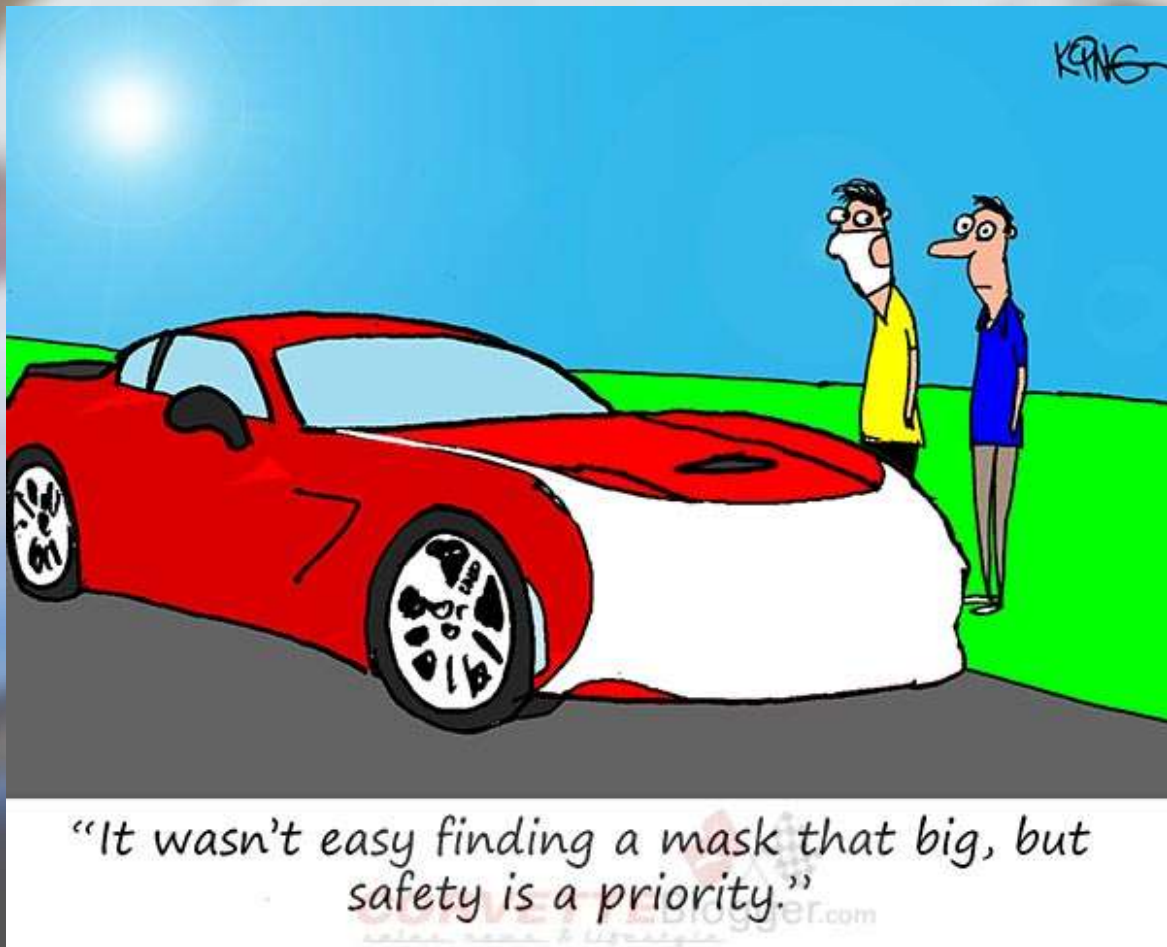
