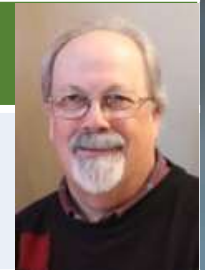

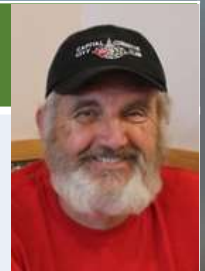

Hello members,

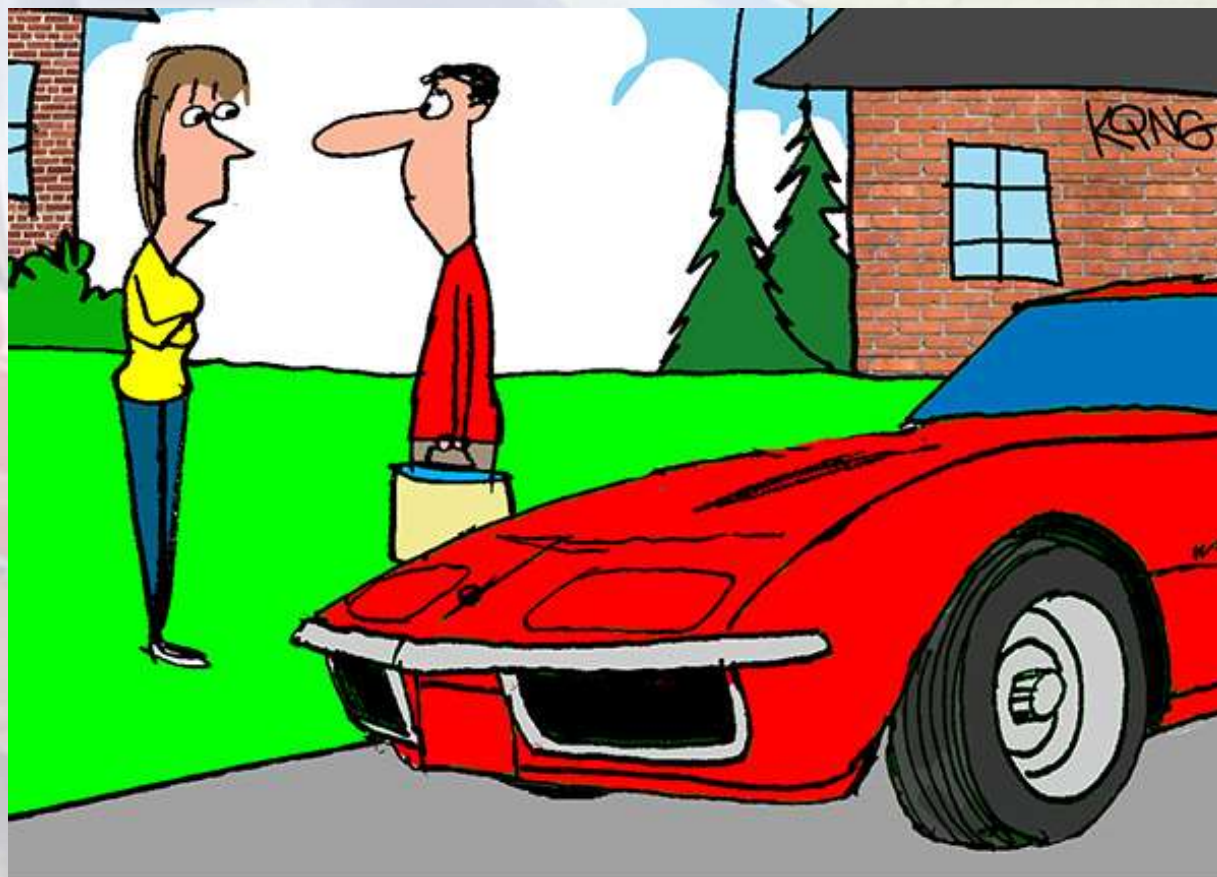

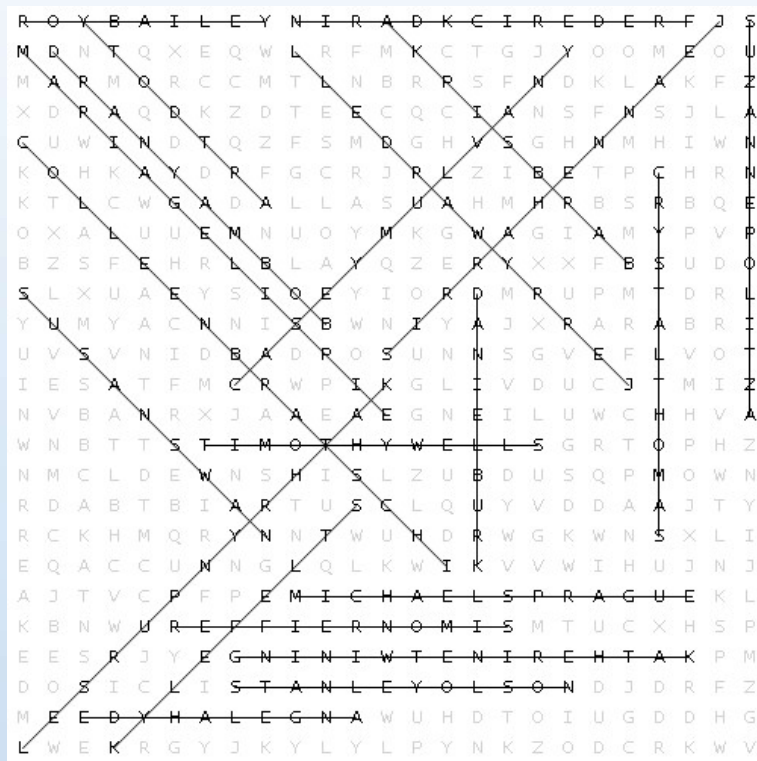

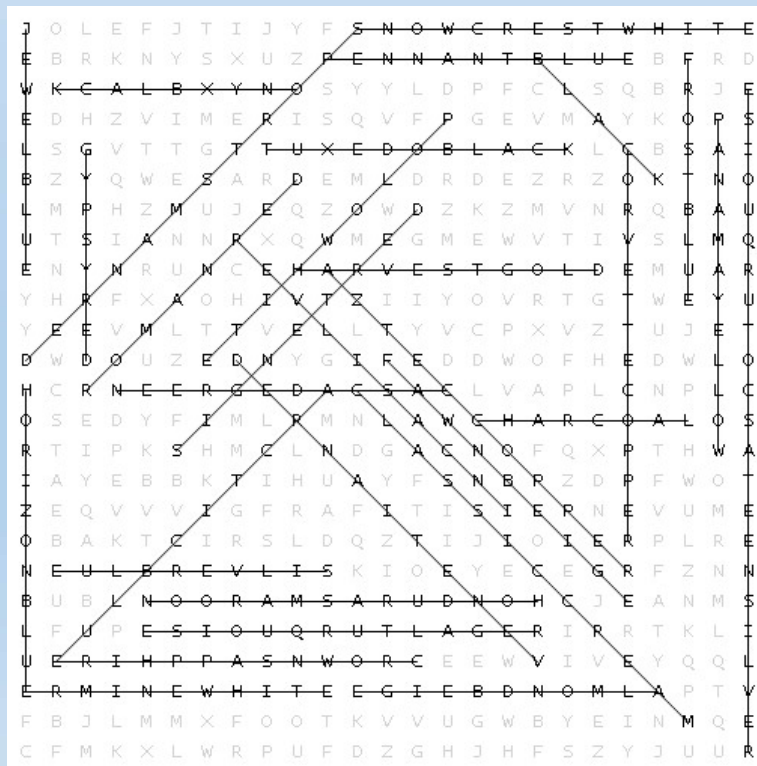
