It's held at the Eaton Proving Grounds, southeast of Marshall. After registration and tech inspection, Rene Cardenas walked us around the course, explaining how we should approach each section, which consisted of chicanes, tight turns, short straightaways, and a Chicago Box. Then, we had seven runs each in the morning and afternoon with a seasoned autocross pro in the passenger's seat. The training was very helpful, as the instructor tells you how to get quicker in each section. It was a good way to spend some quality time with my son, while we burned some fossil fuels and squealed some tires in a legal and safe setting.


