

Event Flyers (cccorvette.org) Attached is a flyer for a type of NCCC event called a Funkhana that we haven't had here in MI in guite a while. This coming weekend in Perrysburg, OH we will be doing a trial test weekend to see if this type of event draws any interest in our Region's membership to encourage clubs to perhaps host some of them next year in conjunction with car shows or rallyes or by themselves. We have 20 participants signed up already or 10 Corvette teams consisting of a driver and a navigator. Funkhanas are events that consist of the teams doing silly tasks from inside their Corvettes. We are doing Funkhanas that will not require excessive speed or any particular racing skill to perform and if the vehicle even moves it will not exceed 10mph. We will not require anyone to get in or out of their Corvettes to perform any physical tasks. They will be similar to gimmick game rallyes, but from inside your Corvette. Due to the Corvettes being stationary or barely moving, we will not require anyone to wear helmets or the need to go buy two helmets to attend. These Funkhanas are designed to attract the non-racing car show and rally participants as well as racers to come and enjoy an event and cheer and laugh at the other teams as they attempt their goofy tasks. If you don't have any plans for this coming weekend and want to come and hang out with other Corvette owners having a good time and enjoy a catered lunch for workers and participants, please let Carolyn or myself know if you would like to come out and give it a try one or both days or if you just want to come and observe and work one of the 7 stations, we will provide you with a free lunch.

The 14 Funkhana events this weekend are being hosted with sanctions from Great Lakes Corvette Club, Corvette Club of Battle Creek, Jackson Corvette Club, Lakeshore Corvette Club and Grand Valley Corvette Association. If you belong to any of these clubs and want to come help out and Chair or Co-Chair one of your own events or participate, please let me know.

Members,






