When I was searching for a C6 Corvette, I wanted one with a back-up camera. Unfortunately, that was not an option for the C6. My kids say I'm a "YouTube certified mechanic" and after watching a number of videos, I decided that it was within my capabilities. I've had good luck buying aftermarket radio equipment from Crutchfield, so I got in touch with them, and found a new unit that included a back-up camera. They also had the bezel to make it blend in well with the dash, installation instructions, and I also bought a patch plug that went from my C6's wiring harness to the new unit so that I didn't have to splice a bunch of wires together. Removing the center console on the C6 is pretty easy. I had to tap into the right side back up light wiring to power the back-up camera, and drill a hole in the back tail panel to run the back-up camera's video cables through. I then snaked a piece of small PVC pipe from front to rear underneath the trunk carpet and ran the video cables up through that and then under the carpet and center console to the new head unit. All in all, it can be done in an afternoon, and I now have a better head unit that includes a back-up camera.
