- The only item in the mail was a thank you card from the VFW Children's Home for our most recent donation.
- Kyle also mentioned three members who were going through some health challenges (Kathy Duncan, as well as Connie and Mike Britz).

7:05 Board Reports:

Secretary: Tim Wells

 No additions or corrections were made. Motion to approve February minutes: Tom Faupel, seconded by Simon Reiffer, and approved by the majority of the membership in attendance.

Treasurer: James Sutherland

All bills are paid and the books are balanced.

V/P Governor: Simon Reiffer

- NCCC's newly elected Treasurer resigned during the February 25 Governor's meeting in St.
 Louis. The E-Board presented Tammy Dewitt for the position and the Governors approved her.
 All appointed officers and committees were reaffirmed by the Governors.
- Discussed a Standing Rule change that would put the Rule book change vote on the electronic ballet and change how the vote is taken. Currently it is an "all or nothing" rulebook vote. The suggested change will be to vote for "groups" of changes. This Standing Rule change will be voted on at the May 6 meeting. Check Deb Murphy's email for Rulebook changes. (3-day weekends / # of sanctions / national awards)
- People's Choice Concours is being changed to Car Show to eliminate confusion with the judged concours events. This distinction is being made because points are awarded differently between these two types of events.
- Three proposed By-Law amendments went to the By-Law committee for review.
- NCCC currently has 17,520 members and 234 clubs. Huron Valley Corvette Club is no longer
 affiliated with NCCC because less than 10% of their membership paid NCCC dues. Kalamazoo
 Corvette Club is now the largest club in Michigan with 145 members. Three Michigan Region
 members passed away: David Waters, JR Biksacky, and Patrick Dolan.
- Membership cards have been mailed. New and late renewal members will get a card with their name and number on a label on the back, instead of printed on the front.
- 680 are registered for Convention. Rooms are available at the overflow hotels. Events and tours are almost full. Cost goes up April 1. Day passes will be available April 1. Let me know if you order a Convention shirt. I can pick it up at the May 6 Governor's meeting.
- K&K is NCCC's new insurance carrier, saving NCCC \$3,500. Continue to use the insurance certificate and waiver currently available on the NCCC website until it is updated. Participants must sign the waiver themselves. In other words, you can't sign for your spouse or significant other. Non NCCC Members are not covered by the NCCC insurance policy. This includes FCOA members. Signed waivers must be kept on file for 2 years.

- Waivers are required for club events such as drive and dines, breakfasts, sanctioned and non-sanctioned competition events, etc. Information flyers must be available to all members, notification in the website/newsletter, to be covered by NCCC Insurance.
- Spontaneous events are not covered by NCCC insurance.
- Per Allen Morris, NCCC Business Manager, waivers are no longer required for club meetings.
 We can continue to use the waiver, prepopulated with members names, for membership meeting attendance. All other events must use the new waivers.
- NCCC donated over \$14,000.00 to St. Jude last year.
- Complete Governor's meeting minutes and committee reports will be available on the NCCC
 Website on the "Members Only" page at a later date. Gloria sent out the username and
 password in January. Contact her if you would like the information again.
- The next Region Meeting will take place on May 2, and the Governors Meeting will take place in St. Louis on May 6.
