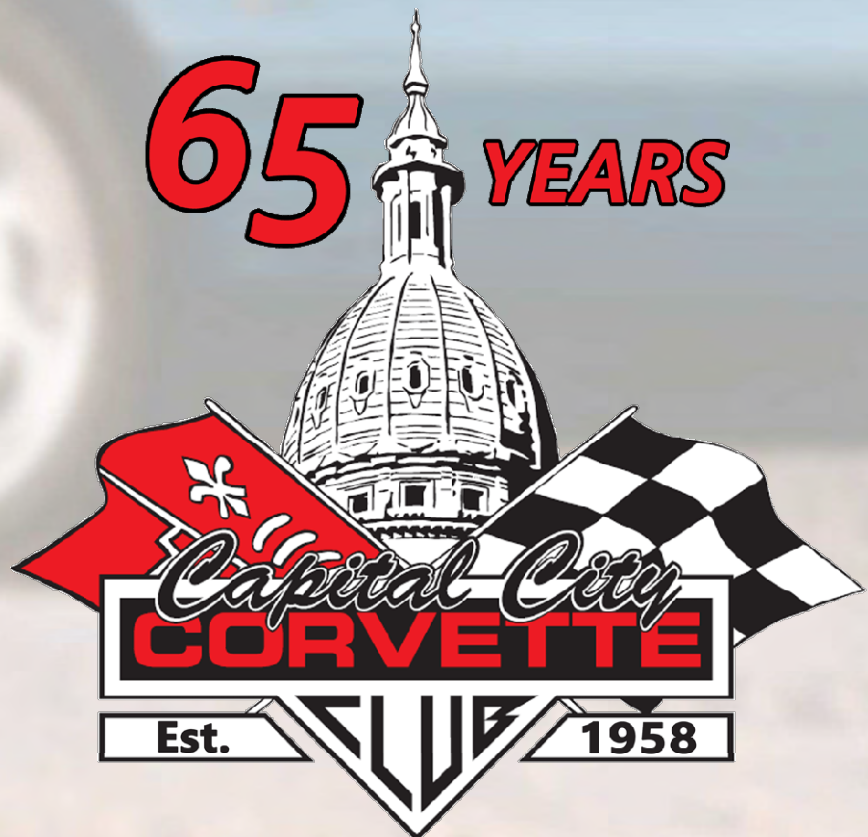
Membership Meeting Minutes

- Denzel brought up the judging of the cars. He is a Certified Judge for Aircraft and has been judging them for years. They have 3 categories, Classic, Original and Custom. Cars should be judged the same way. We need to have judges that will judge the cars in the same way, not friends or associates doing it the way they feel is appropriate. Maybe the criteria for judging cars should be addressed and changed. Kyle explained that for the NCCC this is done through our competition directors. It would be addressed by our Club Competition Director, they in turn would go to the Regional Competition Director and it would then go to the National Competition Director.
