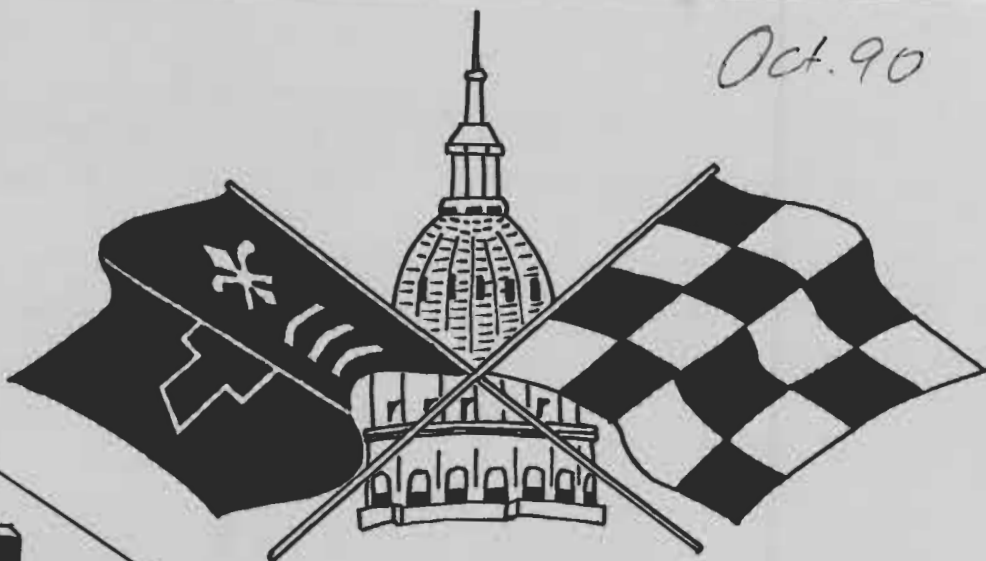
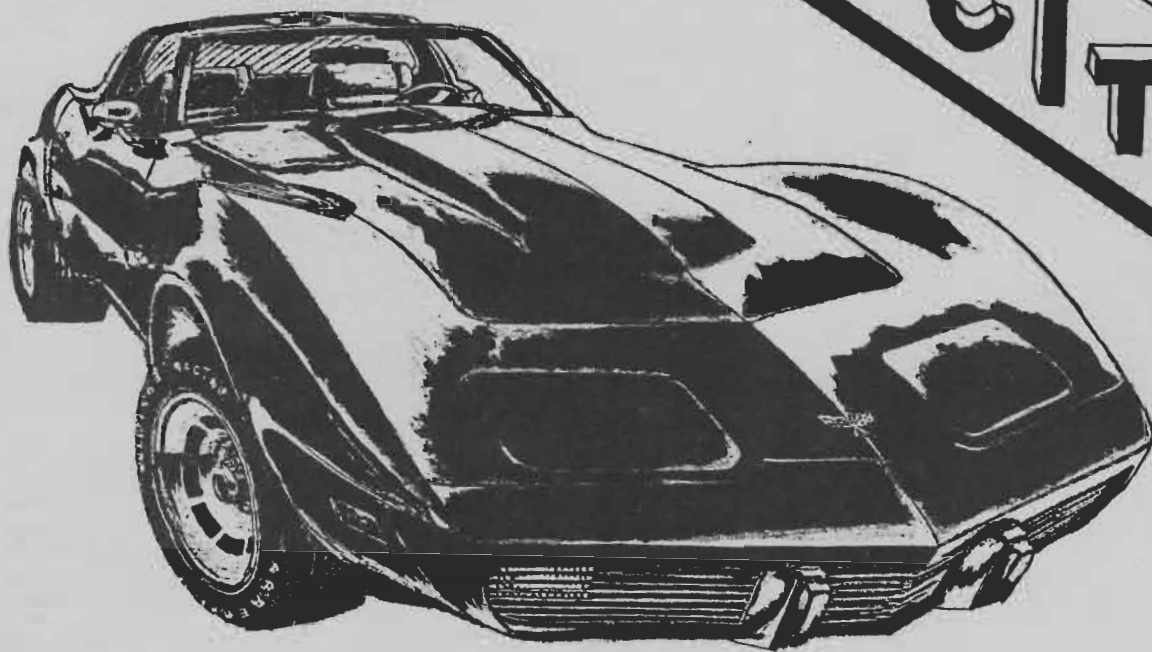

MEETING MINUTES OF THE CAPITAL CITY CORVETTE CLUB

Wednesday, September 5, 1990 at 7:00 p.m. at the Union Hall

The meeting was called to order at 7:10 p.m. by Club President, Ray Goldsborough. Approximately 20 members were present.

The President called upon the Membership Chair, Marv Shreve, for his report. Marv introduced 2 new members in attendance, and added that one other person had joined. Other people are being recruited to join our club. If anyone knows of someone interested in joining please let Marv know.

Marv also stated that he had sweatshirts for sale and a special note will be made to include this information in the next newsletter of September 27th. Should anyone wish to purchase a sweatshirt please call Marv at 321-4313.

The President called upon the Treasurer, Tammy Spinrad, for a Treasurer's Report. She had no official Treasurer's report available to present to the club members.

The Club President informed the members that a new address had been assigned to the Club. The new Post Office Box is 27295, Lansing, Michigan 48901.

The President called upon The Governor and Competition Chair, Sandi Carpenter, for her report. There is a Michigan Region meeting on Tuesday, September 11, at the Quality Inn by Frandor. The meeting starts at 7:00 p.m. Anyone is welcome to attend.

Further, the weekend of September 14-16 there is a Governor's meeting. Sandi will report the outcome of that meeting at the next CCCC meeting on Wednesday, September 19, if we get rained out from miniature golf, or at the October 3, 1990 meeting at the Union Hall.

Sandi Carpenter, Competition Chair, stated that the season was coming to a close. However, a few events are still scheduled including a Concours on September 7 at the Kent Mall in Grand Rapids, sponsored by the Grand Valley Corvette Club; Drags in Stanton on September 22; September 23 two rallies are planned in the Benton Harbor area by the Benton Harbor Corvette Club; Huron Valley has scheduled Matching Times and 2 Low Speed Events on September 30.

Sandi also stated that the Michigan Region needed one more sanctioned Concours Event (Regions need 5 sanctioned events) and that two rallies with the Shiawassee Corvette Club had been planned in October. However, since the Michigan Region needed one more Sanctioned Concours event, one of the rallies scheduled was dropped and a Concours event was put in. The Concours will be put on by CCCC on October 13, 1990 here in Lansing, at Shaheen Chevrolet on South Logan. Flyers will be distributed at the Region Meeting on Tuesday, September 11. Further, Shaheen Chevrolet may do advertising for the Concours.

The other Rally will still take place with the Shiawassee Corvette Club and is classified as a poker and fun rally. Anyone interested - please contact Sandi for further details.

The President called upon the Points Chair, Art Doty, for his report. A points list was distributed the end of August in lieu of a newsletter and no changes have been made to that list at this time. Included in that distribution was a notice of a Softball game with the Jackson Club on September 9th at the Holt High School. Everyone is welcomed!!

There was no Secretary Report as the Secretary was absent.

Club President continued the meeting with a report of the Social Events, etc., coming up along with OLD and NEW Business:

- Newsletter is scheduled at Eifert's on Tuesday, September 25 at 7:30p.m. Please try to attend!!

- Gave further info on the Softball game scheduled on September 9th. It will start at 3:00 p.m. with a pizza party afterwards. Players are needed and family and friends are all welcome to participate.

- Saturday, September 8, is a gathering at the Pig Pit from 3:00 p.m. to 11:00 p.m. on South Cedar (K-Mart/Meijers area). Also an event is scheduled at Andrews Chev. in Mason from 5 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. the same day.

- After the meeting this evening the Club will go to Reno's on West Saginaw for dinner. Everyone welcome!!

- There will be no meeting on September 19 as we have scheduled a miniature golf game at the Saginaw Highway FunTyme for 7:00 p.m. Afterwards we will go to Coscarelli's for dinner.

- The next CCCC club meeting is set for October 3 and dinner will be at Richard's - North U.S. 27.

- The October 17 meeting of the CCCC will be held at the Union Hall and dinner is scheduled for DeLuca's on Willow Street in Lansing.

- Ray stated he had heard about a car show at Frandor but had no further details. Will try to find out more.

- Rally is scheduled for Octber 27 - see Calendar or Sandi for details.

- Ray has also been in contact with the Jackson Corvette Club to try and work out a social event for this fall. Perhaps a regular golf game in the Mason area.

Charlie Eifert, Editor Spokesperson, reminded all members of

the newsletter gathering at his home on September 25th at 7:30.

Club President Ray discussed further business - informed the Club members that Skory Auto Sounds will take an ad spot in our Club Newsletter.

Also that Factory Representatives from an Alarm Company that puts alarms in all kinds of cars, also sells bras and other items for all types of cars will be coming on November 7 or 21. Perhaps we might want to take in one of these dates in place of a regular club meeting. Further discussion will take place at either the September 19 meeting or the October 3.

Club President informed the membership that there were advertising spots available in our newsletter. Jim Myers stated that Gary Drago from Flint was interested. Also Ray informed the membership that some of the advertisers give discounts to members of CCCC. For a list of these advertisers please see Ray.

At the next CCCC meeting, October 3, future meetings dates will be discussed to work in with the Holidays.

It was mentioned that a new corvette will be given away this weekend (September 9) at the North Kent Mall. Cost is \$10.00 per ticket and proceeds will go to Spina Bifida. In addition, the Kent Mall is sponsoring a Corvette Car show the entire week, September 9 through 17, if anyone is interested in putting their car in or going over to see the display.

Club President discussed the traditional CCCC Swap Meet to be held on April 21, 1991 at the Mason County Fair Grounds. Negotiations are being held to obtain a contract, price, etc. and should be finalized soon.

Discussion was held concerning the official CCCC jackets that were voted on at the August 1st meeting. The color is going to be royal blue with yellow letters and the corvette flag emblem. Discussion was held on changing the color of the jackets, letting people have a choice of color, etc. but it was stated that a motion had passed at the August 1 meeting and that the jacket style and color were staying as voted on. A motion was made by Marv Shreve and seconded by Jim Myers to have the outline of the insignia on the jackets black. The vote was 15 in favor. Two people voted to change outline color to white. It was stated that the jackets should be uniform for all club members. A sample of the layout design for the jackets was passed around. The club will pay for the logo and if members want their names on the jacket it will cost \$5.00. Names will be put on the front. If a member wants the logo (small version) on the front it will cost the member \$10.00. An order form will be placed in the September newsletter.

Dave Cripe is handling the jacket order and asks that proper sizes be put on the order form. He needs an exact chest size and will go by that when ordering the jackets. He stated that many manufacturers have different sizes but that in this case this information was necessary to get the right size for

everyone.

The President then called for a vote for the three positions open for Chair of the January Car show at the Lansing Arena, the June Car show at the Lansing Mall and the Swap Meet in April.

Those nominated for the positions were: Tammy Spinrad for the January Car Show; Sandi Carpenter or Steve Spinrad for the April Swap Meet and Marv Shreve for the June Mall Car Show. Ballots were passed out and the results were:

January Car Show - Tammy Spinrad
April Swap Meet - Sandi Carpenter
June Mall Car Show - Marv Shreve

Club President called for any info regarding Sell and Swap. Nothing was brought up.

Additional Info discussed:

-Spartan Speedway may be coming back to let us use their track for racing. This was stated by Steve Spinrad.

-Ray Goldsborough mentioned that the State Police area on Canal Road was being used for speed eventg and also that some speed eventg were taking place at Plant 5 parking lot (Oldsmobile).

Additional info was given to the Club on the October 13th Concours that Linda Weaver was Chair and Jim Myers was Co-Chair.

Jim Myers also asked the Club for input in holding meetings only once a month, possibly on Sunday. It was also mentioned that we could have twice a month meetings in the summer when activites were heavy and go to once a month in the winter. This was brought up by Mike Walsh. Further discussion will take place at the next meeting. A by-law change will have to be made and voted on for this to take place.

If any other members have by-law changes, please take or make them available at the Board Meetings.

Next Board Meeting is scheduled at Ray Goldsborough's home on Thursday, September 20.

Penny Myers informed the membership that a Concours was going to be held in conjunction with the Swap Meet in April of 1991.

Ray, Club President, called for a very brief Board Meeting after the Club meeting and prior to going to the restaurant.

Jim Myers made a motion to adjourn and it was seconded by Nancy Doty. Meeting adjourned at 8:35.

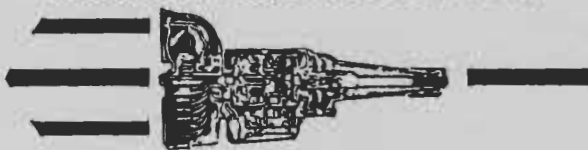

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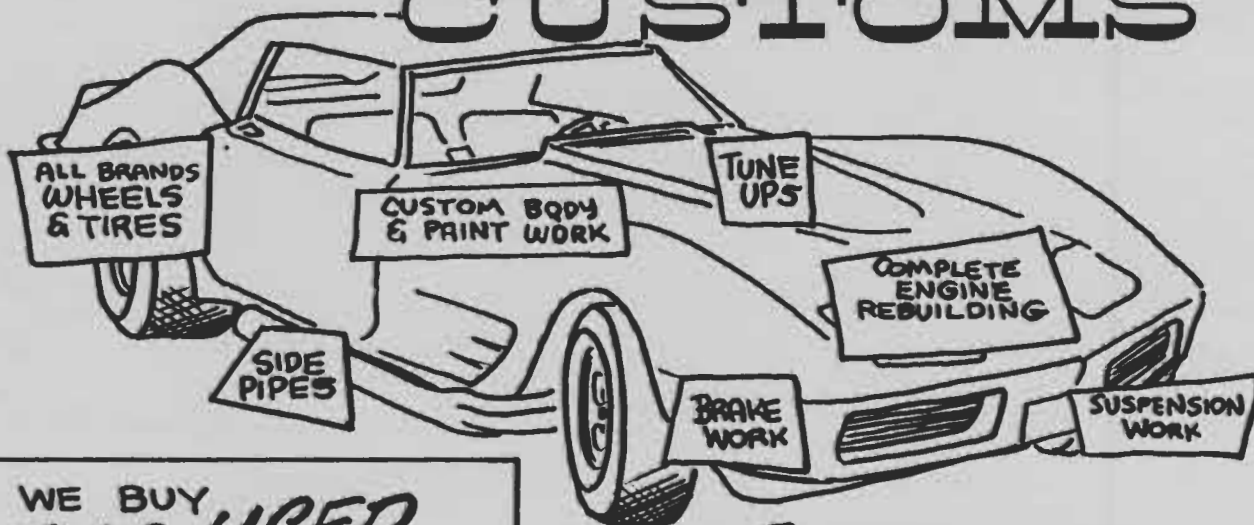

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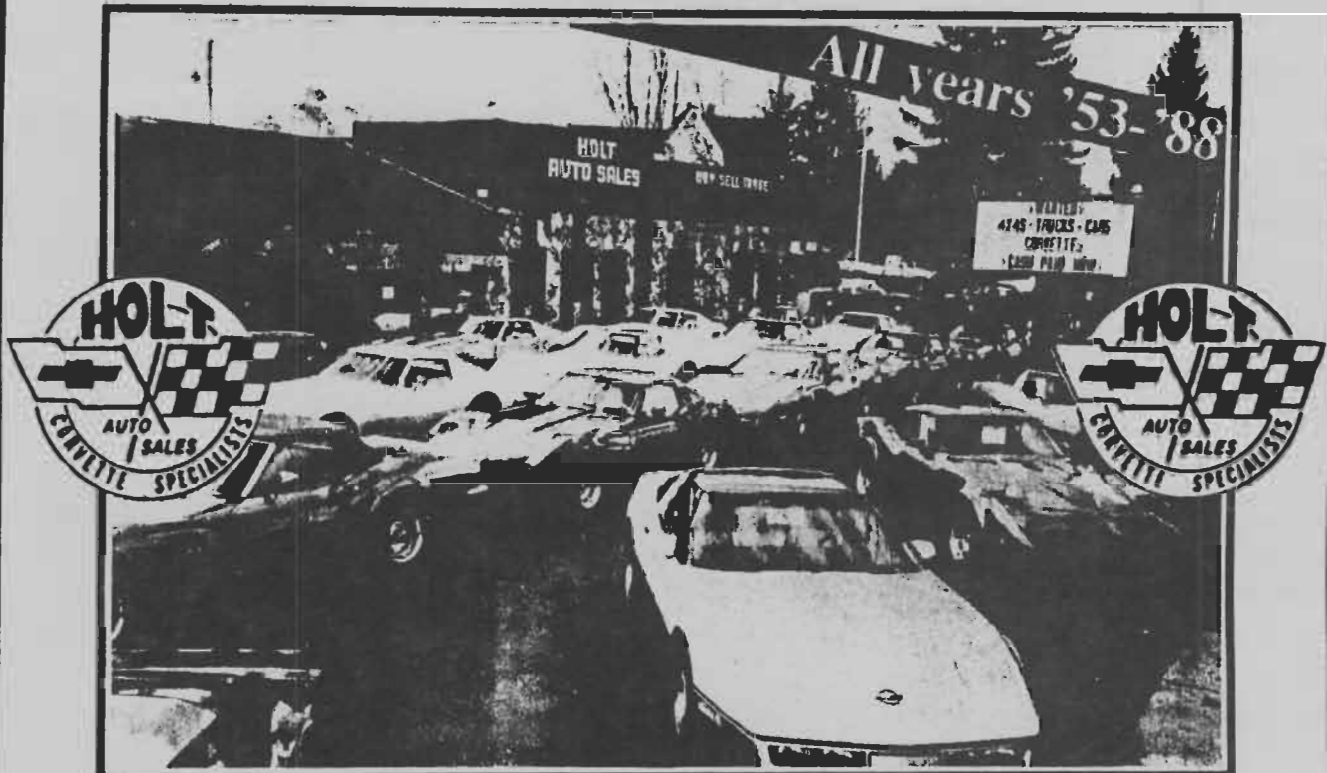
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CORVETTES WANTED

Governors Meeting Sept. 15th 1990 by Sandi Carpenter

This is a condensed form of my minutes for the Governors Meeting. I have not yet received the official Secretaries Report and copies will be available for those who are interested. Just let me know.

The Governors Meetings are held at the Nashville Marriott in Nashville Tennessee. The Governors Meeting is on Saturday from 1:00 p.m. till 5:00 p.m. (?) The Last meeting for this year will be held the weekend of November 2-4. Next years dates are as follow. March 1-2 1990, May 10-11 1990, During Convention on July 14, 1990, September 13-14 1990 and November 1-2 1990.

Friday night starts out with a wide selection of meetings anyone can spectate. I have been asked to sit-on the Convention Steering Committee Meeting run by Marleen DeZeeuw. We spend our time discussing the 1990 Convention and what went right and wrong. We did recieve some good news for those that were at convention and registered for the Drags. A refund of your entrants fees has been approved and should be in the mail soon. The 1991 convention was discussed in detail with lots of neat things going on. Cowtown Texas was also present giving us the details on the 1992 convention to be held in Texas. I have a nice packet available to be viewed by any one concerned.

Elections are also being held on the National Level with all the contenders passing-out goodies and presenting us with a Speech on themselves and why they want the job. There appears to be some stiff competition for a few of the positions. Pat Dolan presented himself well.

Two K & K insurance representatives were on hand to answer some of our ongoing questions concerning our coverage. It was discussed agian about the coverage of a Ice-conna. If your car falls through the ice it along with the driver are not covered. It was explained to us that entrants and there cars are not covered for injury or damage to themselves. But if they were to damage or hurt someone else or something else that it covered. 1 Million is our basic coverage with 4 more Million available to be purchased for a small fee. Also at all High Speed events a special insurance is to be purchased in order to be covered. This can be a weekend package but I feel it is expensive. I asked if something couldn't be done with the Childs waivers we were told must be signed by the parents of every child that is a the event. I pointed out that the form reads like I am allowing my child to be an entrant and not really releasing the organization from liability. They informed us that those forms are only for the minors that may be working the event and infact no other child needs to be listed on any waiver. This brings alot of questions by me, but this is the official word from the Insurance Company. That is until they change their minds again!!!!

There has been much discussion about changes for the rule book and even the way we are running our events. Because about 40% of the time you find yourself in a one car class, it has been discussed that maybe we should not only bump for Trophies but for the points too. This is something that I feel should be looked at very closely. It was discussed that we need to make competing easier for more people to do, but I feel some of these ideas will in fact discourage even the ones that are participating now. Remember these ideas are only being discussed. More points for more in the class, firesuits for all, up to Snell Helmet rating to 85, 3" belt widths for all 5 point harnesses, 1/2 studs for racetires, fuel lines on RP'S on the outside of the cock pits, allowing the chairman to run the events, these are some of the items that our Regional Competition Directors have been hashing over in their Friday night meetings. Also it was asked what do you want to do with Group I tires?

Sectional Bids were discussed and Mid Ohio is bidding against Michigan Region for the North Sectional. Michigan Region wants the Gratton Track on June 8 & 9 1991 and The Ohio Region want the Mid-Ohio track August 17 & 18 1991. This issue will be voted on at the November Meeting.

I will type the Clarifications on a separate sheet so it is easier to file in a important place.

NCCC Membership is on the upward climb and Jeanne Koty says Good Job to the Governors and Membership Directors on the Region and Club levels.
