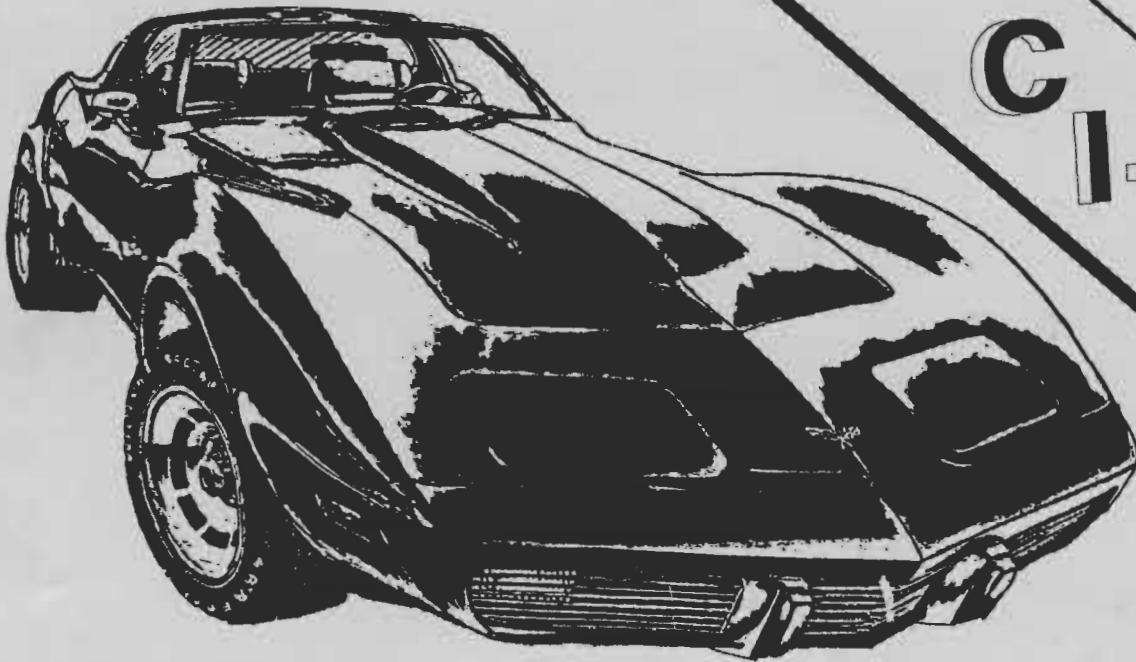
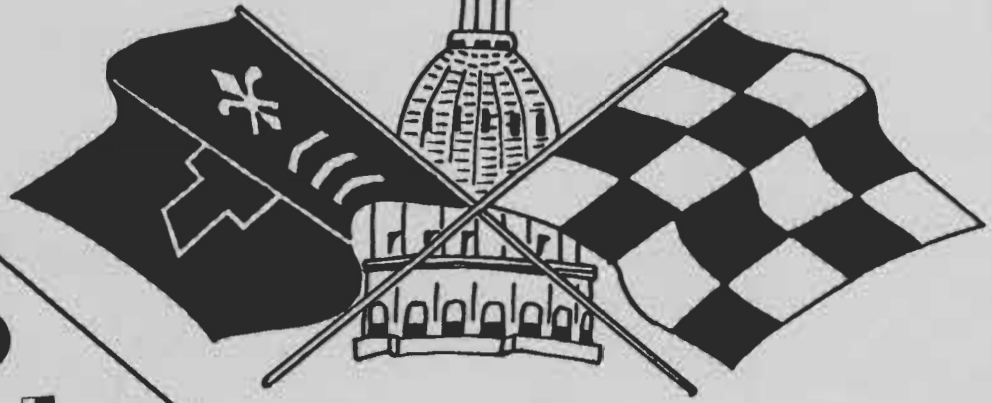

Meeting adjourned 8:20 PM.



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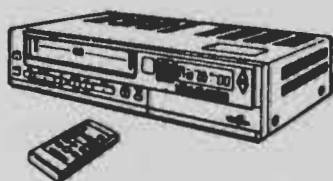
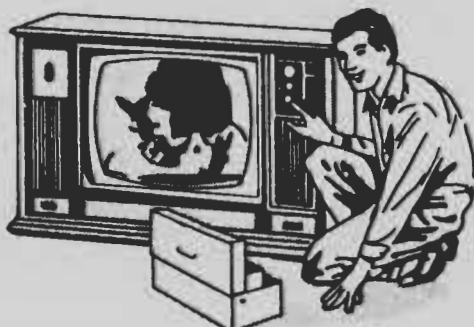

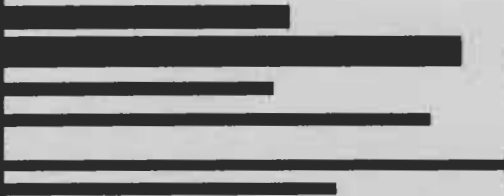
Congradulations and Good Luck Art!!
