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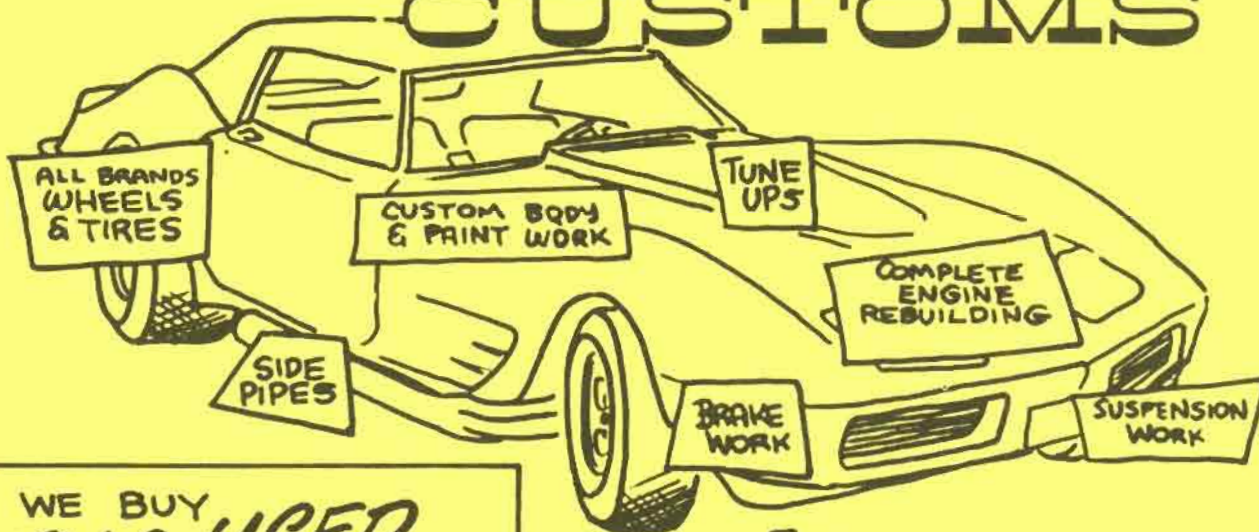
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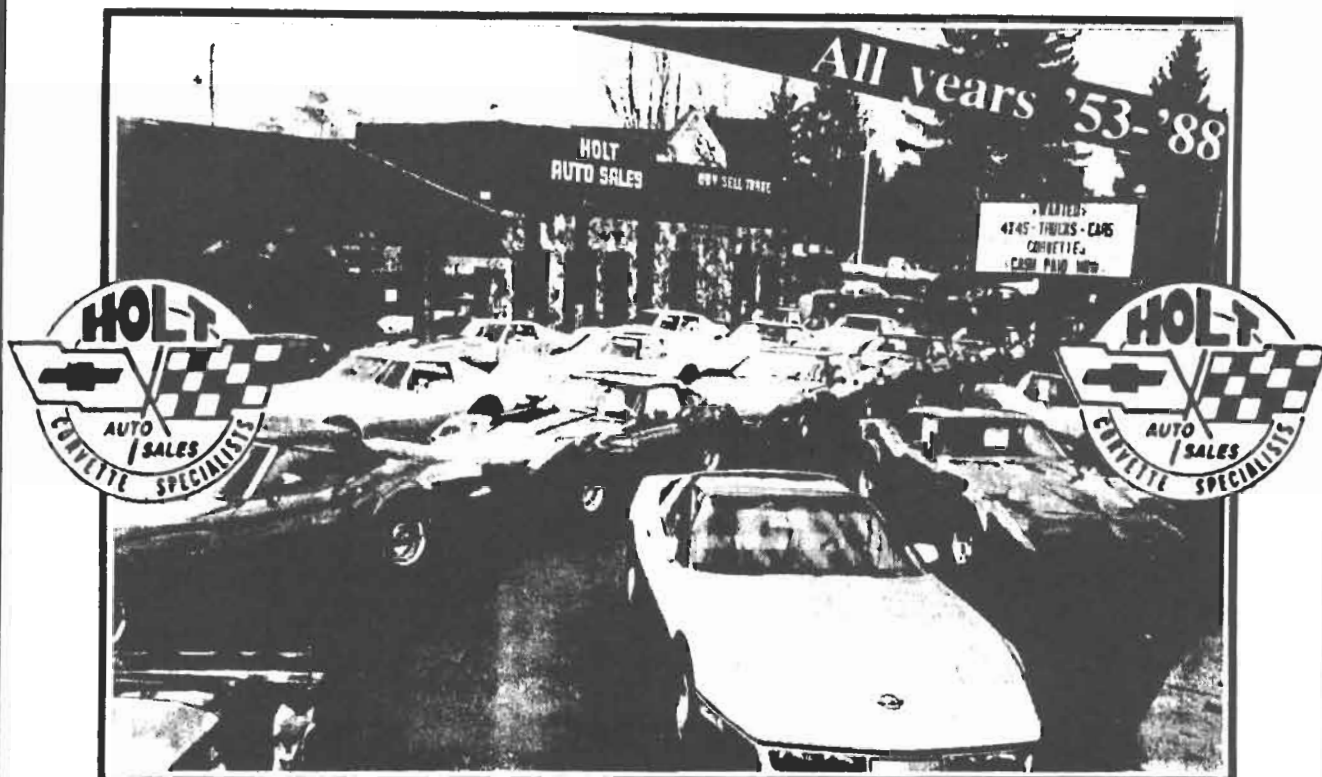
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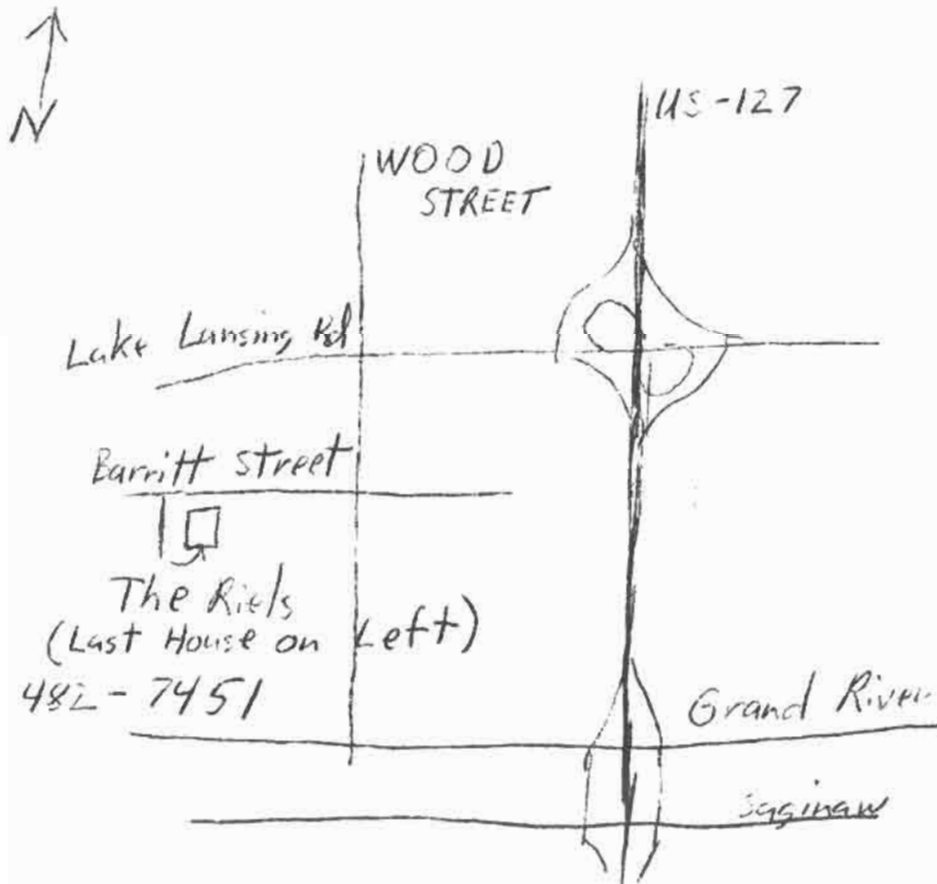
From the Editor's Desk

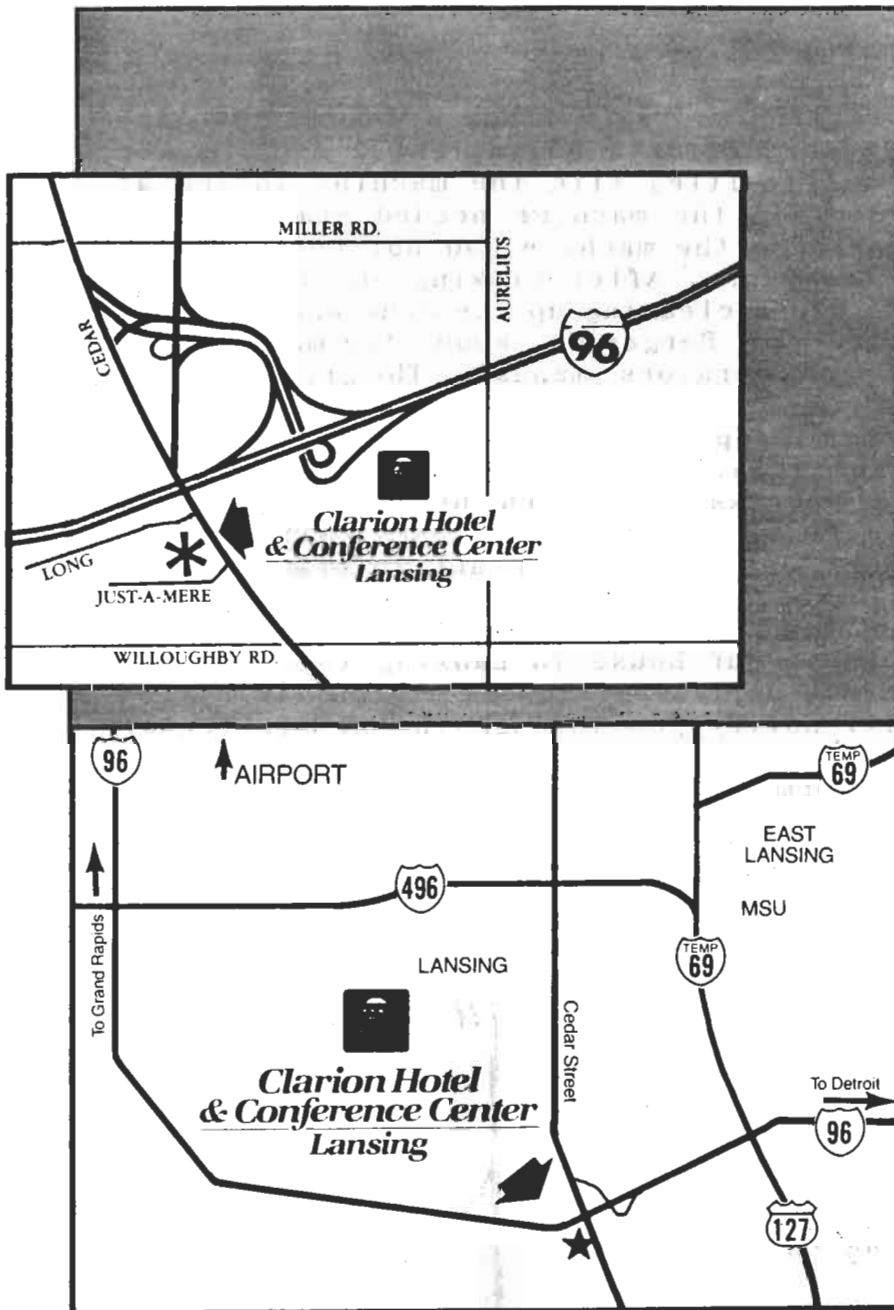

From points North (Mackinac Island and Traverse City)

Take 127 South to Grand Rapids/I-96 Exit. Follow I-96 West to Exit 104 (Cedar Street/Holt). Take Exit 104 and turn left at the light. Go through two lights (2 blocks) and at the 3rd light, turn left. Go under the viaduct and the Clarion Hotel will be on the right.

From points North-East (Flint, Saginaw, Bay City)

Take 69 West to 127 South. Follow 127 South to Grand Rapids/I-96 Exit. Follow I-96 West to Exit 104 (Cedar Street/Holt). Take Exit 104 and turn left at the light. Go through two lights (2 blocks) and at the 3rd light, turn left. Go under the viaduct and the Clarion Hotel will be on the right.

From points East (Detroit and Canada)

Take I-96 West to Lansing Exit 104 (Cedar Street/Holt). Take Exit 104 and turn left at the light. Go through two lights (2 blocks) and at the 3rd light, turn left. Go under the viaduct and the Clarion Hotel will be on the right.

From points South (Cleveland, Toledo)

From Cleveland and Toledo - Take 23 North to I-96. Go West on I-96 to Lansing Exit 104 (Cedar Street/Holt). Take Exit 104 and turn left at the light. Go through two lights (2 blocks) and at the 3rd light, turn left. Go under the viaduct and the Clarion Hotel will be on the right.

From points South-West (Chicago, Kalamazoo and Battle Creek)

Take I-94 East to 69 North. Follow 69 North to I-96 East to exit 104. Turn left at the first light. Go through two lights (2 blocks) and at the 3rd light, turn left. Go under the viaduct and the Clarion Hotel will be on the right.

From points West (Grand Rapids and Muskegon)

Take I-96 East to Lansing Exit 104 (Cedar Street/Holt). Take Exit 104 and turn left at the light. Go through two lights (2 blocks) and at the 3rd light, turn left. Go under the viaduct and the Clarion Hotel will be on the right.

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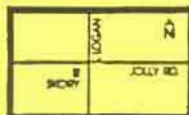
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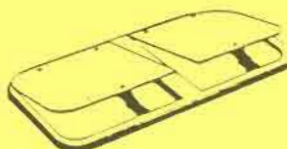
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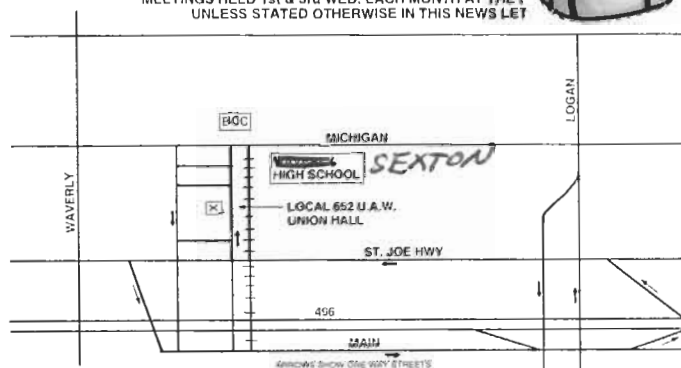
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
