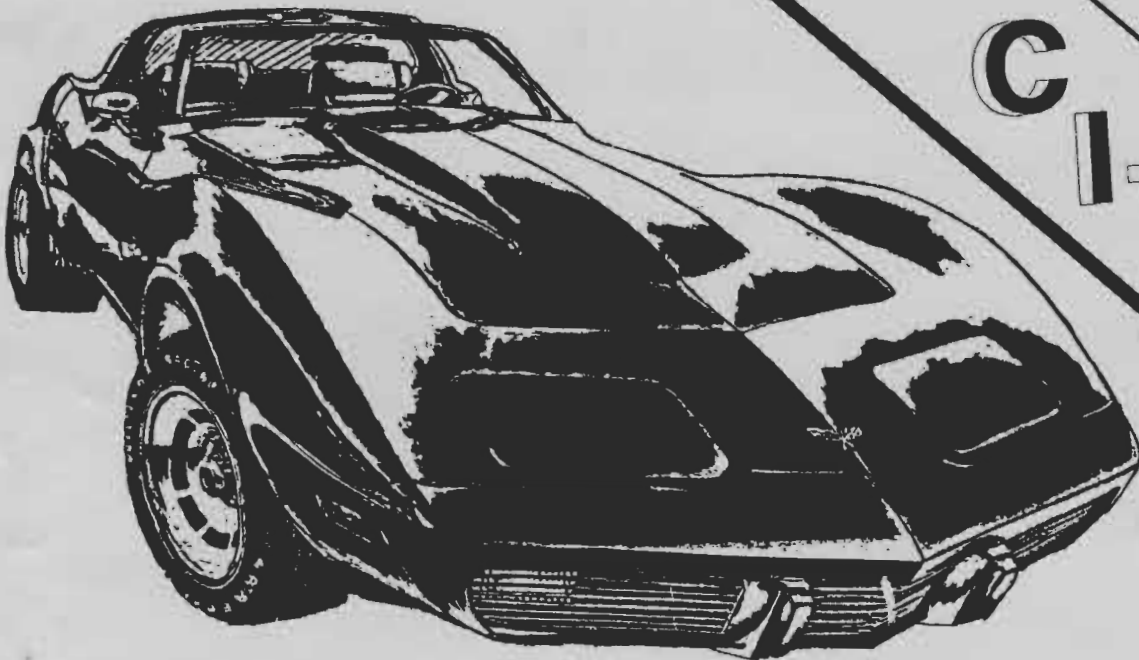
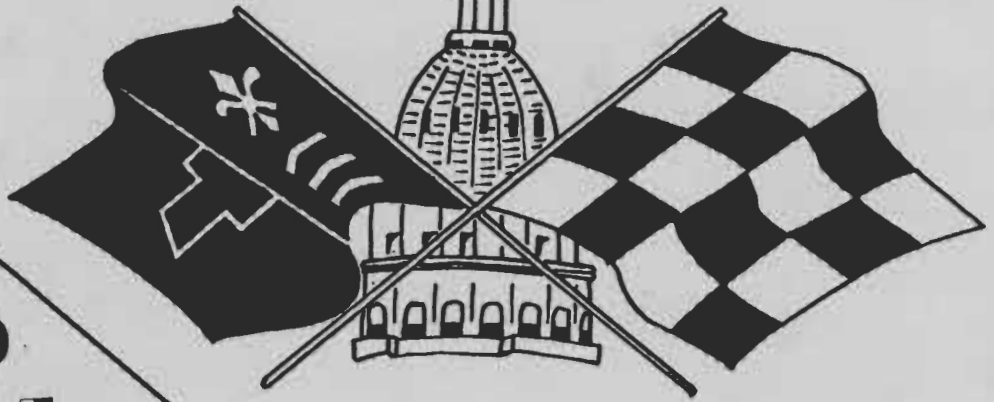

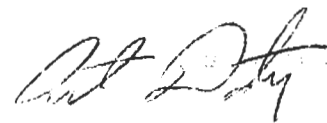
Howdy :

For April we have a Rallye on the 13th a saturday and on sunday the 21st your club will be hosting our annual swap meet along with a concourse we need all the help we can get , so come out and get involved .

For those of you who haven't had much experience with Rallyes let me share a few thoughts with you . To start with as soon as you get the directions (usually as leave the starting line) pull out of the way , stop and read them through . You are looking for lines out of sequence , directions that say delete any lines or anything that doesn't seem to fit . Sometimes on the last page will be a list of things that are good for bonus points generally the rallye-master will tell you about these but not always .

One other thing if this is one of your first Rallyes and mileage is a factor in scoring try to run the Rallye without going back to look for clues you missed . it will probably cost you more in messed up mileage than the question was worth . Also it may no longer be there . If so you lose twice .

Points - Point standings read. Compiled list will be in the newsletter. Points program is almost ready, and a copy will be made for each member and distributed when ready.

Public Relations - Went to Kalamazoo Swapmeet to persuade some vendors to attend our swapmeet in April. Received favorable responses from vendors and the swapmeet was very well done.

Editor - Next newsletter is Wednesday March 27th at 7:30 pm. at the Riel's house. Contact Marty for directions. We need more people to attend newsletter night and we need more articles.

Competition - At the Michigan Region meeting Marv Schreve received an award for 1st place for concours. Congratulations! There is a rallye on June 1st by our club with Tammy Spinrad as Rallye Chairman and Mike Walsh as Co-Chairman.

Social - There are many events going on with other clubs, and a calendar will be made and published in the newsletter. (Read some local events going on.) A calendar of events will be coordinated with Competition.

Governor - Full report will be given at the next meeting. Some of the topics were rule changes with speed events and concours. The topic of concours was tabled at the governors meeting until next time.

Old Business - Bylaws meeting needed and will try for presentation of the bylaws at the next meeting.

New Business - Car Show expenses which included trophies and display articles came to \$416.

Motion - Motion made to approve expenses for the Concourse of \$417 was made; seconded; voted: unanimously.

Motion - Motion was made to amend the Bylaws to have one meeting a month for general membership and the second meeting a month to be for board members; seconded; voted: passed.

Motion - Adjourned at 8:14 pm.

CCCC MEMBERSHIP MEETING

3/20/91

Meeting called to order at 7:13 pm.

Acting President - Art in Sandy's absence.

Membership - Bob Benco (1984) with a prospective new member (his neighbor) Ralph Huss (1962). We would like to welcome Mary Ann Tillson to the meeting. Also we added four new members at the last meeting (two couples), bringing the total members to 56.

Governor - At the governors meeting three weeks ago it was reported that the National Council has 7303 members, the largest club was Corvette Troy with 123. NCCCC Treasurer gave his report and the balances were read. Next was NCCC Competition Awards; CCM was awarded 9th overall club participation : Mens awards; Dean Bohne 1st, Scott Bayo 2nd : Womens awards; Sue Brown 1st, and Debbie Corbin 7th. For the convention, all Non-NCCC participants must be certified to drive a high speed event or have appropriate proof of low speed events run. Quadra challenge rules - must have standard production DOT tires for the events and they must be the same tires for all the events(not concours). They do not necessarily have to be BFG's.

Proposed 1992 rule book changes: 1. Helmets - Snell 1980 or newer;

2. Firesuits - Required in Group III and only recommended in Groups I & II , this includes socks and gloves.

3. Roll-bar specs and materials - 1 1/2" diameter, 1/8" tubing not pipe, and braces shall be attached to the main hoop with a minimum angle of 30 degrees and 6" from curve.

4. Drag Certification - An events chairman may require a driver to demonstrate his/her ability to drive.

Nominations are still open for the 92 officers - Competition, Secretary, Business Manager & Sergeant at Arms. Also for 1992 is proposed meeting sites which are Nashville, Louisville and Indianapolis. The Bowling Green Museum is accepting \$100 donations to be a Charter member until May. Insurance for any NCCC sponsored event includes participants and guests. The 1991 Convention is at Charlotte, North Carolina. Speed events will be held at Charlotte Motor Speedway and the Drags will be held at Rockingham. The 1992 Convention will be held at Cowtown (Fort Worth), Texas and the proposed 1993 Convention is at Topeka, Kansas.

Competition - April 13 GVCA will be putting on a rally.

Social - After the meeting tonight the club will be going over to the Dispatch. Future eating-after-meeting places are as follows: April 3rd.-Huddle, April 17th.-DeLuca's, May 1st.-Coscarelli's, May 15th.-Richards.

Treasurer - Balances read.

Public Relations - No report given

Editor - Newsletter will be next Wednesday (3/27/91) at 7:30 pm. at the Riels house. If you are planning on sending flyers to advertise an event see Marty to get it printed up. Any articles for the newsletter, please get them to Marty before Wednesday. We also need more ink and paper - Marty will get from H.C. Berger.

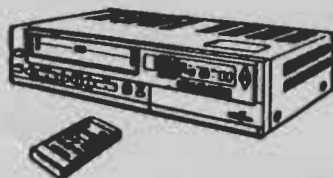
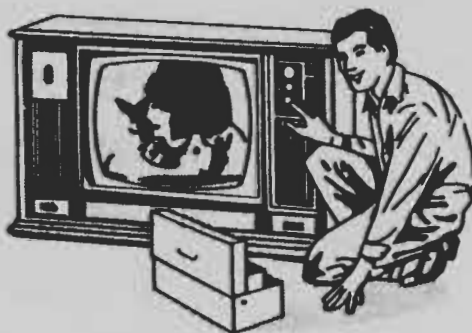
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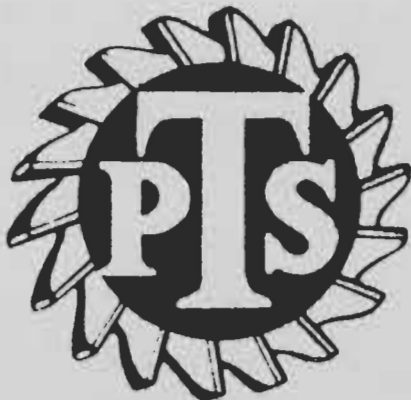
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From the Officer of Public Relations

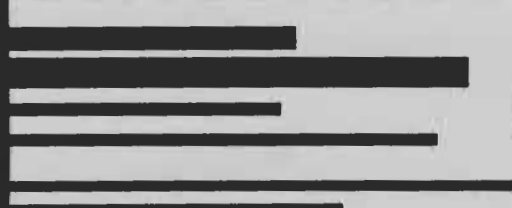

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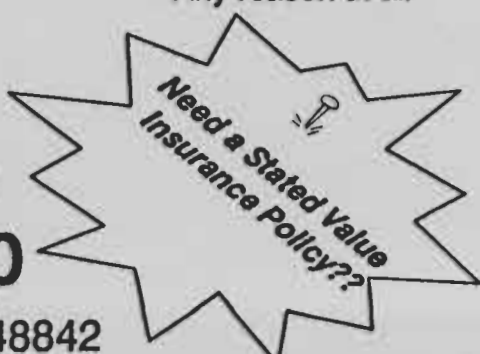

ONLY EVENTS PUT ON BY CAPITAL CITY CORVETTE CLUB WILL BE CONSIDERED FOR POINTS. THESE ARE THE ONLY EVENTS THAT WILL BE CONSIDERED AS CCCC SANCTIONED. THIRTY DAY NOTICE SHOULD BE GIVEN BEFORE AND EVENT. UNDER SPECIAL CIRCUMSTANCES, THE COMPETITION VICE PRESIDENT CAN MAKE EXCEPTIONS. IN MOST CASES, "NOTICE" IS DEFINED AS AN ANNOUNCEMENT IN THE CCCC NEWSLETTER.

CCCC POINTS WILL BE AWARDED ON THE FOLLOWING BASIS:

CHAPTER POINTS TEXT

1. A 2 ATTENDING A GENERAL MEMBERSHIP MEETING.
- B 2 ADDITIONAL POINTS FOR ARRIVING AT THE MEETING WITH A CORVETTE-EITHER RIDING, DRIVING, TOWING IT.
2. A 10 HOSTING A CCCC SOCIAL EVENT.
- B 10 CO-HOSTING A CCCC SOCIAL EVENT. (NOTE: ONE CO-HOST PER EVENT)
- C 2 FOR ATTENDING A CCCC SOCIAL EVENT.
- D 1 ADDITIONAL POINT FOR ARRIVING AT ANY CCCC SOCIAL EVENT WITH A CORVETTE: RIDING, DRIVING OR TOWING IF YOU ARE NOT A HOST OR CO-HOST, CHAIR-PERSON.
- E 10 FOR ATTENDING THE CCCC BANQUET.
3. A 20 FOR HOLDING AN ELECTED OFFICE.
4. A 10 FOR SIGNING UP A NEW MASTER MEMBER (FIVE POINTS AFTER THEY ATTEND THREE FUNCTIONS AND FIVE POINTS WHEN THEY RENEW).
5. A 1 PER HOUR FOR ASSISTING IN THE CCCC NEWSLETTER PRODUCTION. THE EDITOR IS ELIGIBLE FOR PRODUCTION POINTS ALSO. MAXIMUM OF FIVE POINTS PER NEWSLETTER.
