





# INFORMATION REPORT MICHIGAN REGION

For those of you who cannot attend the Region Meetings and/or CCCC membership meetings, I would like to take this opportunity to update you on what has been happening in the Region.

First, Benton Harbor will be hosting the 1992 Michigan Region Awards Banquet in March. There is a flyer enclosed in this newsletter giving the pertinent details. In conjunction with this banquet, the region is selling raffle tickets for one night's lodging at the Holiday Inn the night of the banquet. You must be present to win. There is a second raffle ticket with the prize being dinner for two. If you are interested in the banquet or the raffle tickets, please contact Art Doty.




