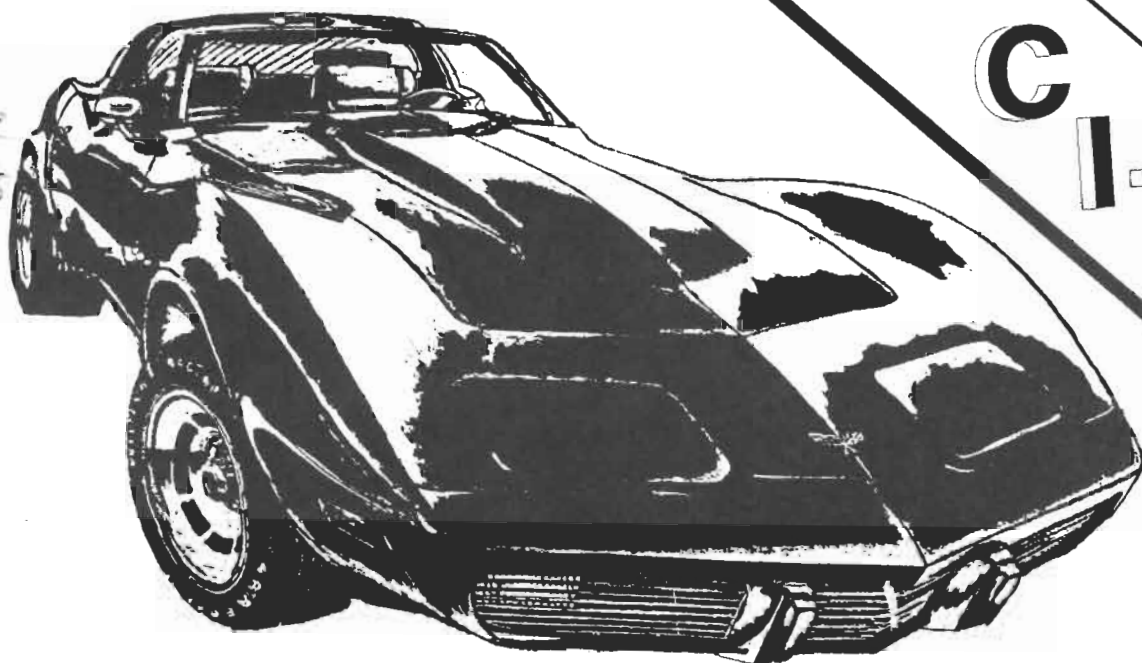
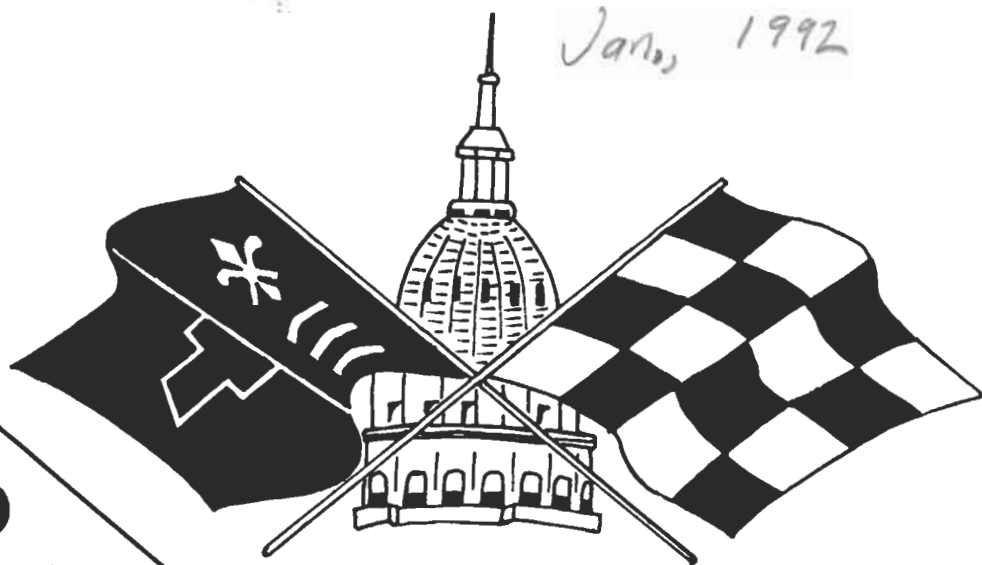

Motion-To adjourn, seconded at 8:38pm.



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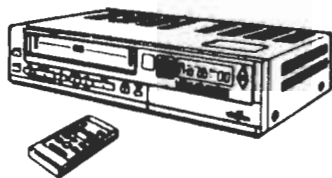
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Capital City Corvette Club

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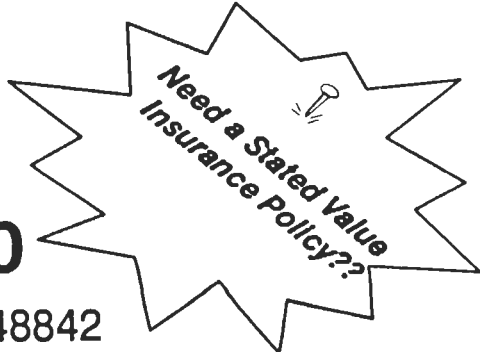

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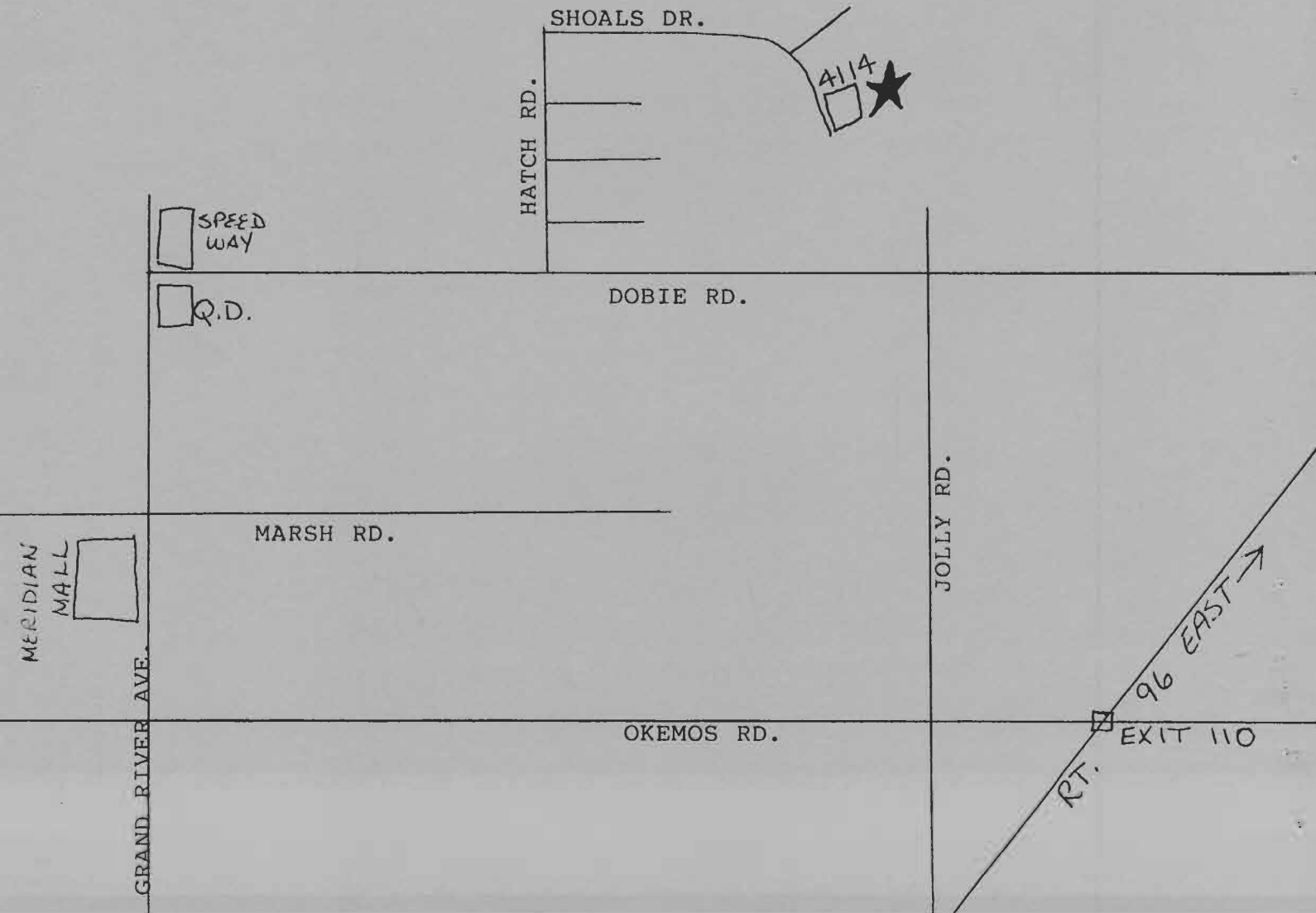
DIRECTIONS FROM RT. 496:

(Look for the grey house with white Christmas lights)

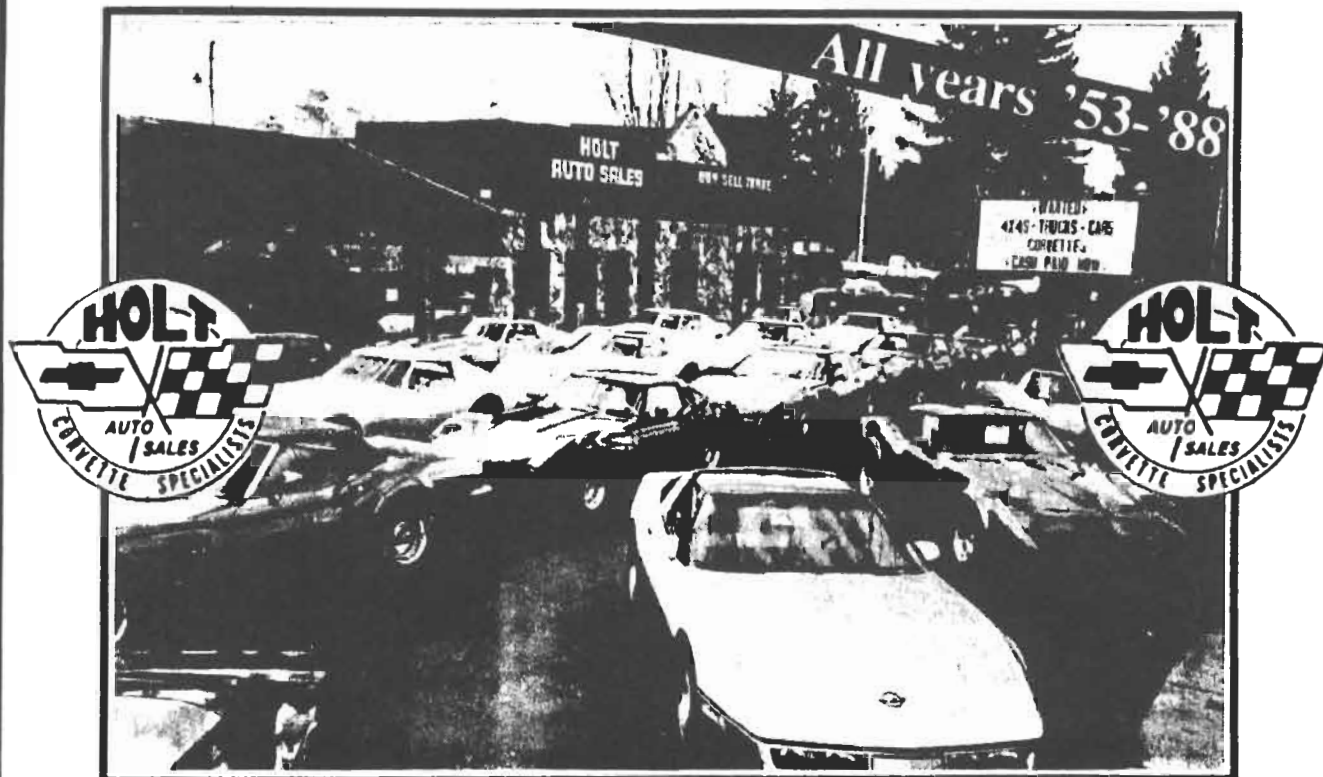

(Look for the grey house with white Christmas lights)



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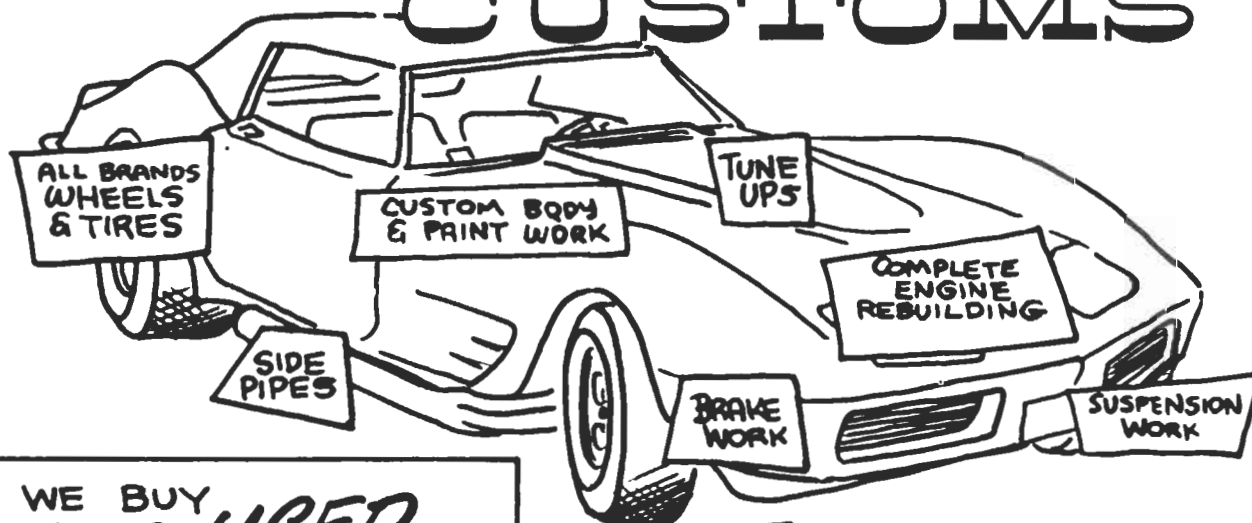
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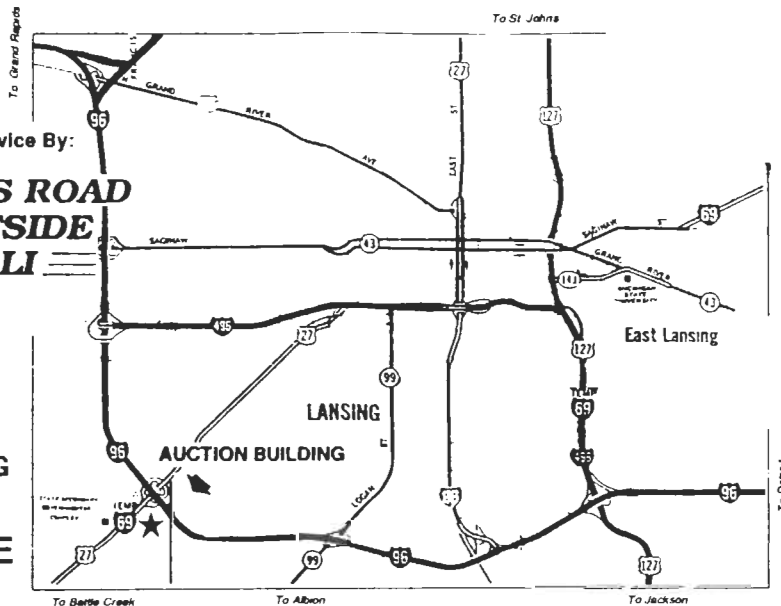
