CORVETTE HELP-NET

This letter will explain the purpose of the CORVETTE HELP-NET and provide some guidelines for it's use.

HELP-NET was conceived with the idea in mind that if you had a problem while taking a trip in your Corvette, you would much rather talk to and receive help from a fellow Corvetter than a stranger.

You probably know a lot of friends in your hometown or club who would be willing to help you, but who would you call in Jackson or Flint or Muskegon? Wouldn't you like an alternative to Joe Bob's Wrecker Service?

Each Governor would sign-up one or more people in their club to be put on this list as a contact person. This contact person could then keep a list, if need be, of other people in the club who would be willing to help when called.

Someone on the list should have a trailer and everybody should be familiar with Corvettes, mechanically, although just having someone to talk to is better than nothing at all. It doesn't take a rocket scientist to help push a Corvette onto a trailer. If you have your name put on the list, you have agreed to provide help, basically, for nothing.

On the other hand, if you call someone to come 100 miles and rescue you, some expression of appreciation should be given. Beer, gas money, wax their truck or all of the above. Put yourself in the other person's shoes; both as helper or helpee.

Also, if you are on the list, you make a commitment to respond as soon as you can or find someone who can. The call may not be a life or death situation, but 5 hours at night in a roadside park or along side the road is an awfully long time to wait.

NO SOLICIATIONS OR DISTRIBUTION OUTSIDE OF CLUB MEMBERSHIP WILL BE PERMITTED. This list will be for contacting someone in case you are stranded and need help. Don't use this list to call and ask about mufflers for your Corvette or to make a mailing list to sell a car. Use the list, don't abuse it!

Each new and current member of a Michigan Region club would receive the list, this letter as a 'rulebook', and a simple map showing approximate hometown locations, so you won't call someone in Flint from St. Joseph.

This idea attempts to go back to the real 'grassroots' meaning of any club: Help your fellow members. This should be an informal, 'help your buddy' kind of thing.

If you would like to be put on this list, let your governor know and they will get in touch with me.
