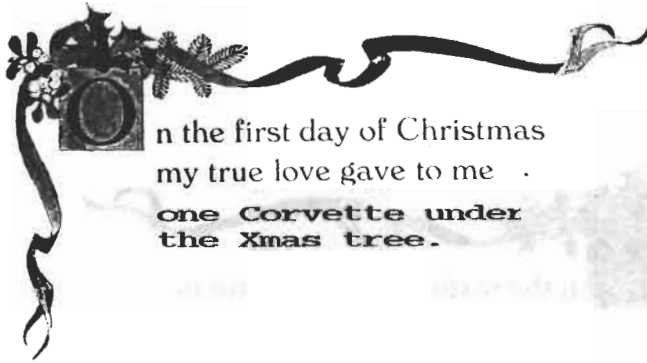
This is only the beginning of our Non-sanctioned Events. We plan to have a full calendar this next year and we will be striving to have events that will be of interest to all members.
