I would also like to note that Bob Reeve won the 50/50 drawing for a total of \$80.00!

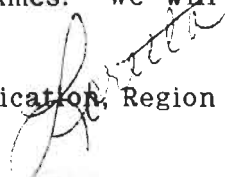
Competition Events

ANTIFREEZE CONCERNS

- Each airplane requires 1000-3000 gallons of ethylene glycol/water mixture for deicing. Most seeps into the ground water or runs off to surface water.
- Drinking four ounces of ethylene glycol can kill a 180 lb. person.
- The lead and copper in used antifreeze is often precipitated into the sludge from a wastewater treatment plant. This sludge is incinerated or land applied, introducing the metals into the environment.
- Non-biodegradable contaminants such as the human carcinogen 1,4 dioxane are a concern during the improper disposal of antifreeze.
