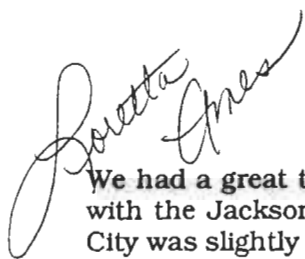

Socially Speaking...

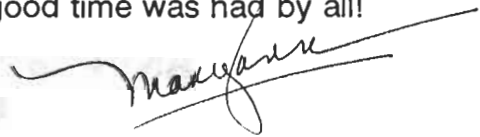
