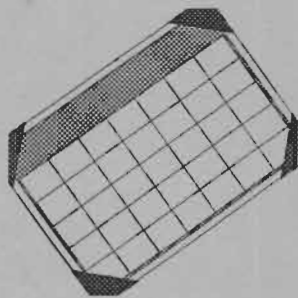

NCCC CONVENTION

Sunday after the Holt Show Steve and I headed for the NCCC Convention in Topeka. For anyone that is interested (I am sure you are probably planning to spend

your vacation there) it is 785 long miles!

If you have never attended a NCCC Convention, it is really hard to appreciate the excitement involved. This year's convention had approximately 800 attendees and over 300 Corvettes. I say over 300 because there was a road tour on Saturday Evening and 300 cars participated. You have to remember there were race cars that need to be counted and there were people that could not make it in time for the Saturday tour.

The competition events were held at Heartland Park Raceway. This is a complete facility for High Speed, Low Speed and Drag Racing. It probably would have been perfect if it hadn't been for the weather.

It rained every morning and cleared to a "hot" 95° in the afternoon. This made the tracks very slippery. In fact, Barry Leone **from the Shiawassee Club landed in the** pond and had to be towed out. There were a number of cars that left the track and tried to clean off the walls. The only cleaning done was their fenders. One driver managed to crumple all 4 of his fenders. But then there were some drivers that managed to make it down the track in good shape, maybe a little sideways or a few 360° turns, but other than that everything was great.

The drags left a little to be desired, but as I said in 98 degree weather it is a little hard to expect a lot.
