Social - Mary Ann has a flyer in the newsletter for the Christmas in August party to be held August 14th at Lake Lansing Park.

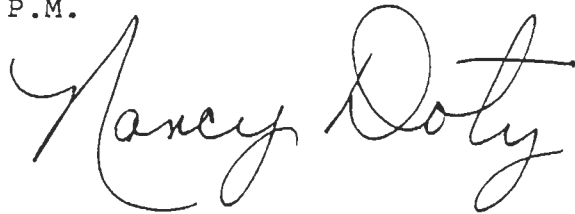

FROM THE CLUTTERED DESK of the GOV.

Now that its over I can tell you about the Dream and Drive tour. Not that it was a big secret but that information was in short supply. When I reported about the tour at the June General Membership Meeting the closest city it would come to was going to be Chicago. At the July Region Meeting, about four days before we left for Convention in Topeka, KA. I learned that Detroit or Milford had been added to the tour. At Convention I signed Nancy and I up as drivers, still not knowing what we would do. At this time we did know the dates would be Aug.13th,14th and 15th by the 10th I still didn't have any new info. so I called Roger Thomas our Regional Executive to find out if I was needed or not. Roger said he would take everybody that could show up at the Chevy Headquarters in Warren at 7:30 AM on Friday. The next day he faxed me directions to Chevy Hq.. Friday morning at 5:30 I was on my way. By 6:30 I was in very heavy traffic, I hardly saw I-275 leave us and head south. About 7 o'clock traffic lightened some and by 7:20 I was in the parking lot talking to several people from the Region who I think should have been working, I won't mention their names to protect the guilty.

After a brief orientation we drove the 11 new Corvettes to the skid pad where a crew was waiting to wash them, after they were washed we brought them back and dried them off. more orientation and it was off to the course set up in the parking lot, most of the cars had two people in them. After a few laps we switched drivers. Finally I get behind the wheel, just as I was cruising through the second gate the tires started to protest, I remembered someone saying no tire squeeling. Now how are we going to have fun? After gate ten we come to a stop sign. But its not over yet. A couple of left turns and another stop sign. Then a four bucket chicane and another stop. A short straight with a quick shift to second on the six speed, damm there go the tires again. I thought they would be quiet with traction control. Before we get started we are stopping again, waiting for a turn at the skid pad. This is the business end of the demonstration. The first time through I shut off both ABS & ATC with the help of a specials installed switch. Approaching the pad which is covered with soapy water at 10mph doesnt seem like much as soon as I am on it I hit the brakes and skid and skid. I turn the wheels left I skid straight, I turn the wheels right I skid straight, wheels straight, the dark green convertible finally stops. Now it doesn't want to drive off, just spins its wheels and crawls away. The next pass ABS & ATC are back on, I drive onto the pad at 10mph, hit the brakes turn the wheels right and its off the pad half way through, some differance!! We repeated this routine about thirty times Friday half with me driving and half with prospective customers driving. Another thirty trips with my co-driver Ameil, an engineer from the Corvette factory. If this sounds like something you would like to try keep it in mind for next year

I think Detroit will be on the original tour next time. We set a record for the number of customers in the program in a single day 291 on Friday. Saturday we tied the new record. Not everybody drove all three days. I took Saturday off to go to a wedding. Sunday morning found Nancy and I on our way to Detroit again this time traffic was much lighter. I even got to look around a little. Much better than staring at the bumper ahead of you. things went much the same as Friday. It seemed like I made fewer trips through the course this time but by 3:30 we had 263 with one class left to go. It looked like a new record was about to happen.

Coming up at the next Governors Meeting in September we will be voting on the question letting 16 and 17 year olds drive in low speed events. As the proposal is written it would be only with a guardian present. A valid drivers license would also be required. This is a rulebook change so will only be passed by a two-thirds majority. Even if it is defeated I think it will be in the new rulebook when it comes out in three years anyway. If you have an opinion on this let Loretta or I know or better yet come to the Region meeting and let everybody know.

In closing, I'd like to say farewell in true Tillson style - no mushy goodbyes, just leave 'em laughing. So stay well and yaw'll don't be no strangers!

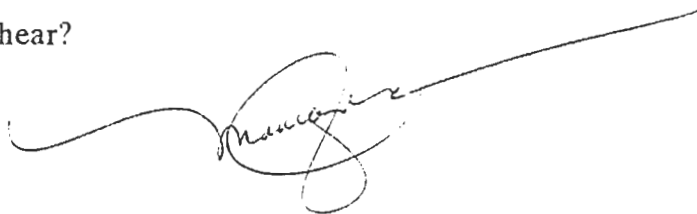
