From the President

This year has been so busy it is hard to believe October is here, but it is and that means nominations. If you are not familiar with elections, and were not at the last two membership meetings to receive your copy of the bylaws, nominations for officers are held at the General Membership Meeting in October and November and elections are held at the General Membership Meetings in December, effective January 1.

TREASURER - the treasurer is responsible for the treasury. This person writes the checks and balances the check book.

MEMBERSHIP - the membership director is responsible for all membership functions, including soliciting new members, mailing annual dues notices, collection of dues, keeping accurate membership lists, and reporting membership changes to the club and National Council.
