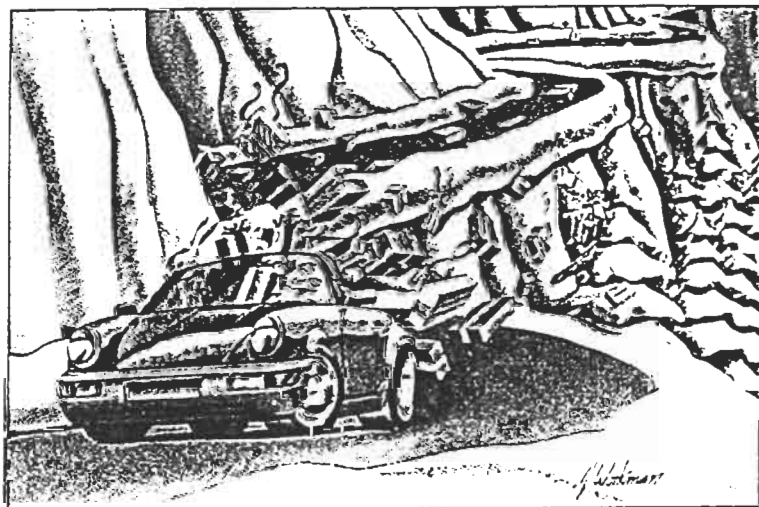

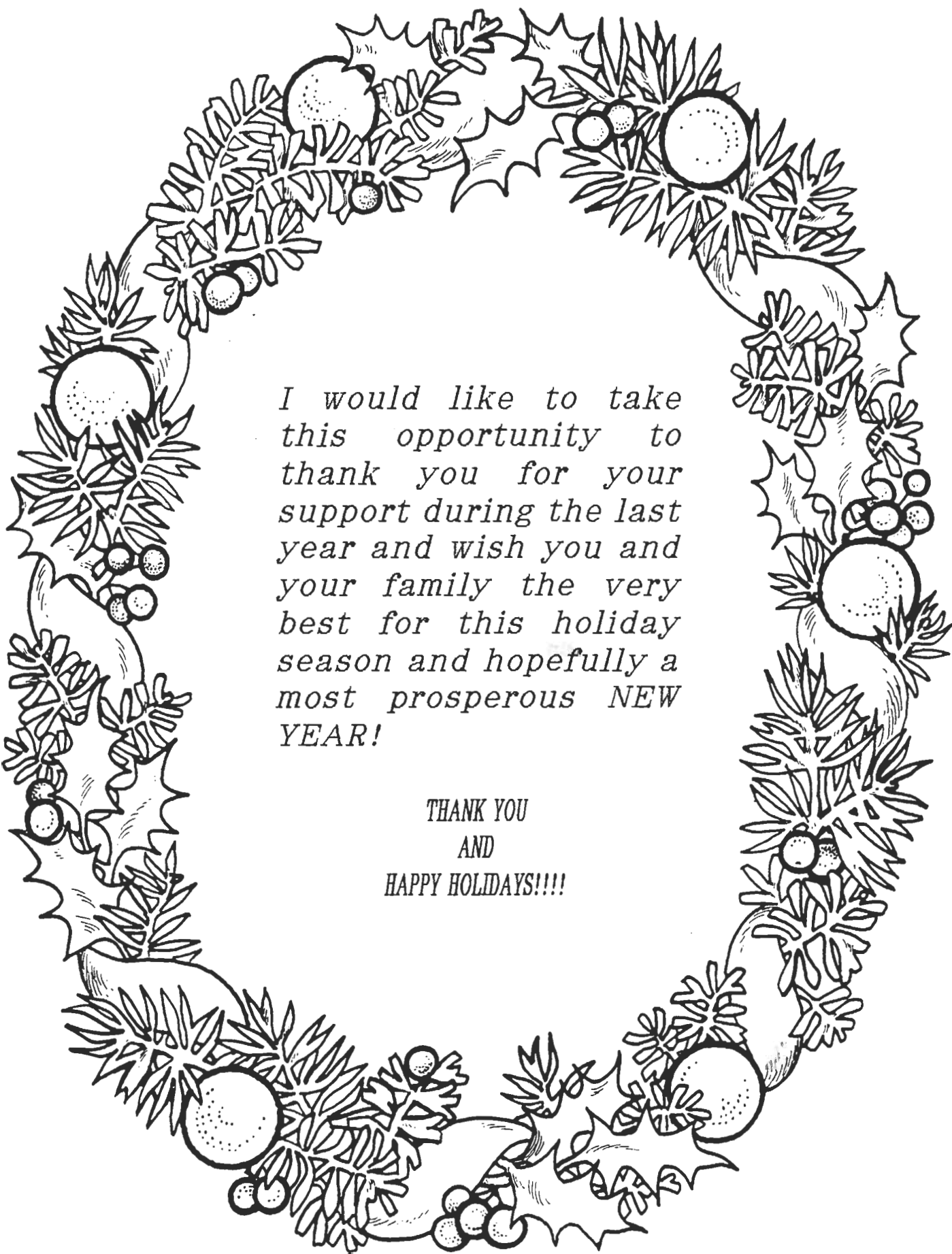
The calendar was also completed for 1994 and as soon as it is published it will appear in this newsletter as always. The dates and Events for Capital City are as follows:

Newsletter - deadline is 11-22-93.

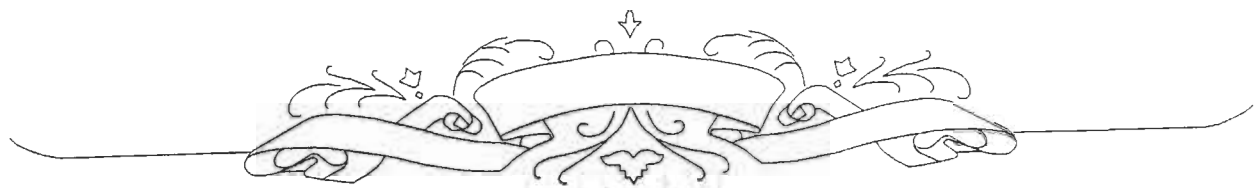
