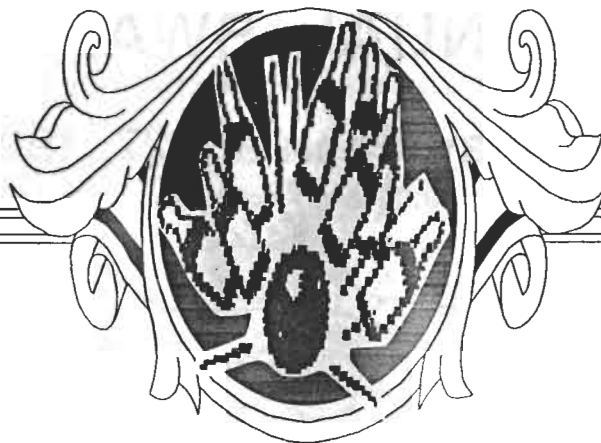
Editor
