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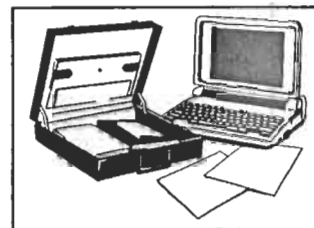

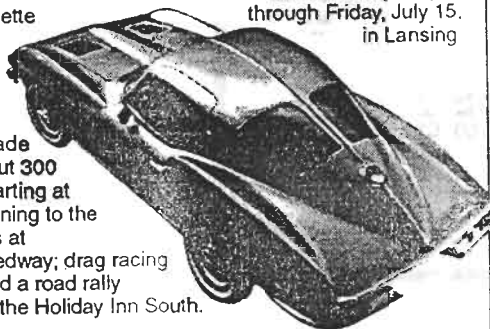

Corvettes will roar into Lansing

The city's streets will overflow with Corvettes this summer, as the weeklong annual National Corvette Convention comes to Lansing for the first time.

Add about 1,000 club members from across the country staying at the Holiday Inn South, and that's about \$3 million expected to flow into Lansing's economy.

"Any time you have an organization like the Corvette Club, which is a national group with a highly visible product... it's a nice piece

of business and we're thrilled," said Tom Galyon, Convention and Visitors Bureau director.

The event will be July 9-15, starting with a parade from Michigan State University to the Capitol, said Loretta Spinrad, president of the Capital City Corvette Club, which will host the event.

The 300-plus cars expected will be on display downtown after the parade. They will range from showroom models from throughout the legendary sports car's 41-year history, to souped-up race versions costing as much as \$100,000.

Downtown merchants plan to keep their stores and restaurants open to help keep the party atmosphere going, Spinrad said.

"We want to make it as festive as possible. We're going to try to provide entertainment with dance groups, hula contests and the People's Choice award, where anyone can vote for their favorite car."

Non-members can participate in the parade and car show, but most of the race events will be for members only.

On Tuesday and Wednesday, Corvette owners will race at Michigan

International Speedway, with speeds reaching 200 mph. Low-speed events will be at Spartan Speedway, with speeds around 65 mph.

Drag racing will be Thursday in Stanton and a road rally will take place throughout Lansing on Friday.

"The races are extremely competitive. A tenth, even a hundredth of a second makes a big difference," Spinrad said.

The convention, in its 35th year, has been in Michigan three other times but never in Lansing. The Capital chapter is a founding member of the national club.

A man and his Vette at rest

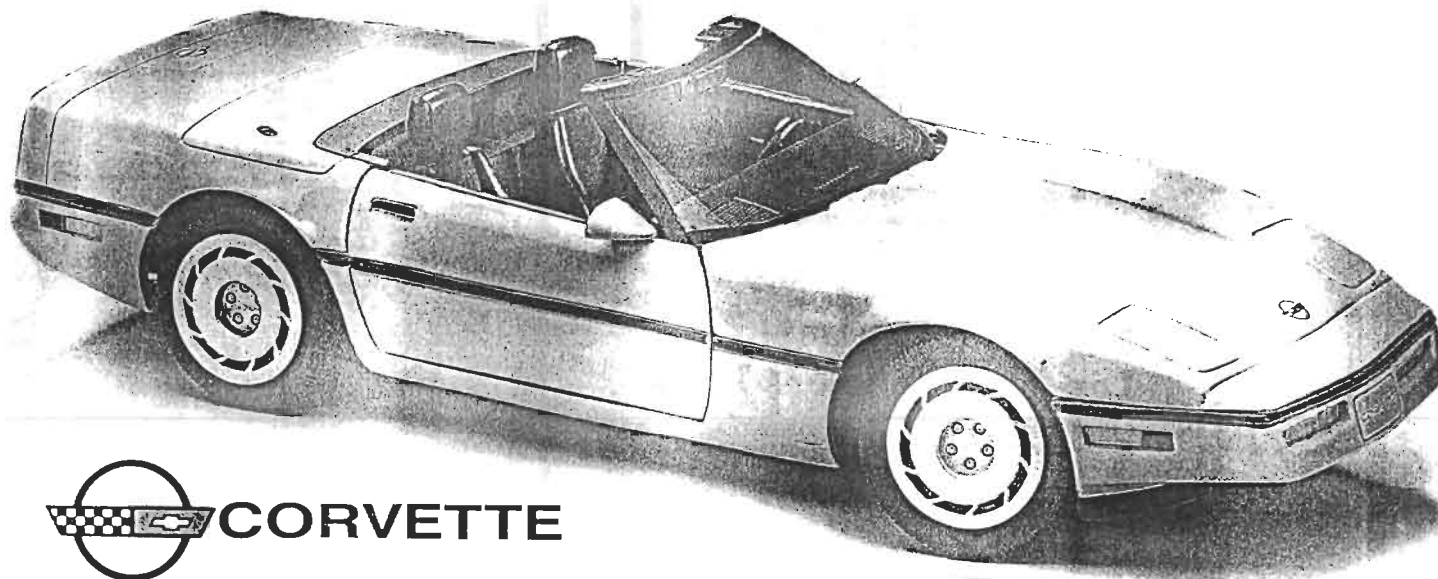

IRWIN, Pa. — If there is a highway to heaven, George Swanson may ride it in style — in his white Corvette.

Swanson's ashes were in the driver's seat — two driving caps in the back, red roses on the hood and 27,000 miles on the odometer — when the '84 Vette was lowered into his 12-plot grave as 50 mourners looked on.

It had been a long haul. Swanson, 71, died two months ago and cemetery officials balked at burying him in his beloved car. They finally agreed.

"George always said he lived a fabulous life, and he went out in a fabulous style," his wife, Caroline Swanson, said at a reception. "You have a lot of people saying they want to take it with them. He took it with him."
