Classified Ads are still in the newsletter. Send them all to me at the address below. This is a FREE service to all. Please get them to me, and I'll put them in the next issue.

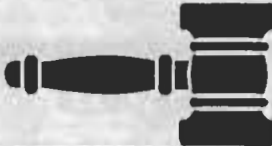
