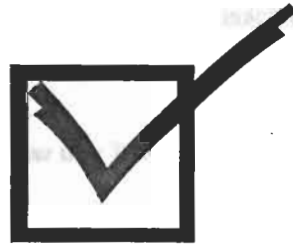
Our video night will also include a Pizza and beverages.

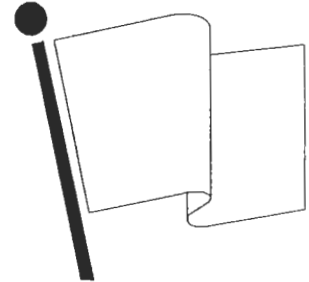
Don't forget about the Video and Pizza Night on Monday, September 19th at 7:00 p.m. Be sure to bring an hors d'oeuvre or dessert to share!
