Competition update . . .

August 1996

With the National Convention behind us, the competition season will once again heat up. There always seems to be renewed interest in competition after the convention as people strive to be one of the top 10 or 12 in their region or nation.

The Michigan Region will be doing our part in the contest for points by offering a number of events for the remainder the season.

This last weekend Corvette Coventry and MAG sponsored 14 events in Benton Harbor with a party at the Thomas's home afterward.

Next weekend (August 3 and 4) will find us at the Owosso Speedway. The Shiawassee Club will host 7 events on the oval track.

If you enjoy track racing, this will be an event you will not want to miss as it is pretty open and fast.

Once again there will be a potluck at the Leone's on Saturday evening.

August 10 and 11 will bring more track racing as the Flint Club will host 6 events at the Auto City Raceway north of Flint. This is actually two tracks in one. A small oval that opens into a larger oval, presently the driver with a bigger, challenge. Saturday night usually brings a Corn Roast at the Janos's home just north of the track.

August 17 and 18 will bring us back to the Spartan Speedway in Mason where the Huron Valley, Jackson, and Capital City Clubs will host another 6 fun filled events on the figure eight track.

Competition updates:

Non-Corvette participants. If you allow non-Corvettes to participate in your events they should follow the same minimal safety guidelines as Corvettes for the classes they are competing in. For example Group I requires Seat Belts and a extinguisher for high speed, non-Corvettes should also comply with these rules. Group III cars are required to have roll bars and for high speed, fire suites, the non-Corvettes should be required to have the same. Bruce Wentzel asked for this clarification which I believe is a very good question. Our rules were designed for the governance of our events and the Corvettes are classed accordingly. Non-Corvettes that are competing in events sponsored by our clubs or covered by our insurance should be required to follow the same rules when appropriate.






