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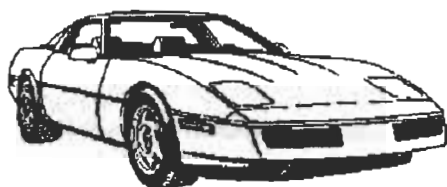

Message from the Points Director

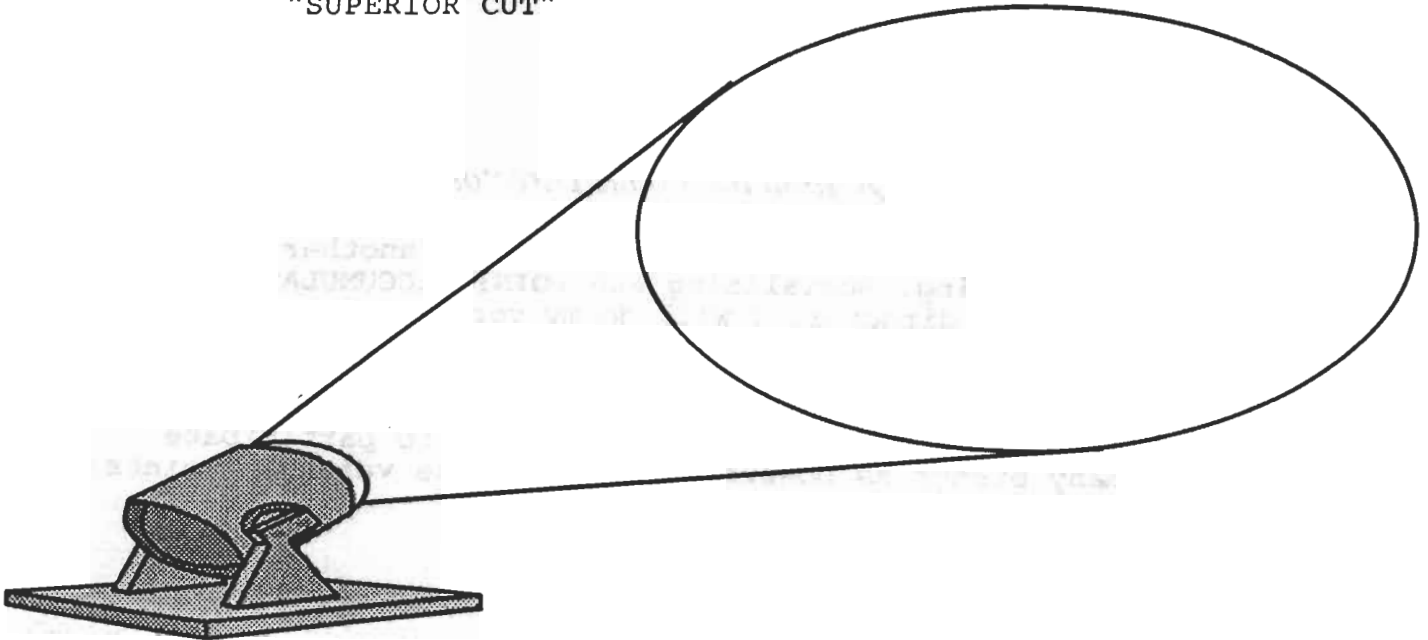

For people that are not interested in gambling we will have "Line Dancing" lessons available, free of charge.

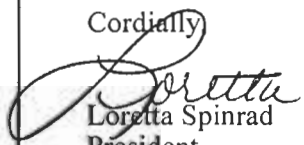
