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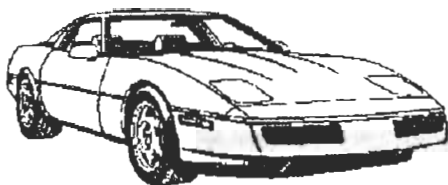

CCM began the season with two rallies on March 16 with a total of 12 NCCC participants, not too bad considering it was still winter in most parts of the region.

The Great Lakes, Huron Valley, and Kalamazoo Clubs will be hosting drag events on May 3 in Stanton. We hope you will have your cars ready by then and have saved room on your calendar for this racing opener. This event is open to all cars and we hope you are encouraging participation among your members.

Drag racing is probably one of the easiest events to start with as you are in a very structured event. You are told when, where, and how. It is a straight shot from the start to the finish and provides a lot of fun for the participant.

There may be people out there wanting to try, but a little afraid to commit. Drag racing is a lot like the take off from a traffic light, and we have all fooled around at traffic lights throughout our days. **So please encourage your club members to give it a try.**

The day will consist of a record drag and two bracket drags. In addition, there will be open testing for all non-corvette, and non-NCCC members.

Even though the events are open to non-members and metal body cars, all cars must meet the minimum NCCC safety standards for the NCCC class they would fall into. Therefore if you are or know someone that is planning to attend be sure they know the rules so they are not disappointed.

CCM will be hosting one Matching Time event on May 4 in the Detroit Area.

The Capital City, Huron Valley, and Jackson Corvette Clubs will be hosting low speed events

at Spartan Speedway (in Mason - south of Lansing) on May 17 and 18. Even though these events are held at a track, it provides fun and a challenge to all category of drivers.

Then are May 26 (Memorial Day) the Kalamazoo Club will be hosting events at the GM plant in Kalamazoo. This year there will be not one, but two low speed events and one matching time.

The Royals are jumping in early this year with not one, not two, but three rallies on Saturday, May 31.

May is going to be a very busy month for us, so you better start getting ready now.

GOVERNOR'S REPORT

Well its 1997, and we have just returned from the first Board of Governor's meeting for the year. Missed all the floods snowstorms or other weather wonders. It turned out to be a long meeting 1:00 PM-6:30 PM. However, there was a lot of good information to bring back to the clubs -

- **Dream & Drive:** Due to the low volume of units that are scheduled to be produced this year, there probably won't be anything until late '97 or early '98. The target production for '98 is 30,000 units and '99 is 35,000 units. Based on previous years, Chevrolet States *"20% of sales during the last few years have come directly from Dream & Drive"*. Sounds like a good reason to continue the program with good results for Chevrolet and good opportunities for us.
- **Scholarships:** Nominations due by May 1st 1997
- **Club in Good Standing:** K & K Insurance says that clubs that do not meet attendance/proxy requirements at Governors' Meetings (attend 3 annual minimum) per year, will be declared a club not in good standing, and will possibly lose insurance coverage for competition events.
- **Factory Tour/Corvette Museum:** Has been canceled for May, due to the factory not being able to provide tours for us - Trying to reschedule for September of '97. I will keep you posted about the re-schedule date - it appears that there will be 200 seats available.
- **Raffle Tickets:** *"Get Em While There Hot!!"* I have the raffle tickets for the '97 car to be awarded at convention, cost, Same as last year - \$10 each - 3/\$25 - 6/\$50. We have 100 tickets available. Since it looks like the Holt Auto event has been canceled, I'll need your help in selling these this year - last year we sold all 50 tickets, this year our goal is a minimum of 55 (one for each club member). This goal or more will earn us the recognition by the Kidney Foundation as a *"100% CLUB."* Obviously this is an opportunity to win a great *"NEW"* car, and support a good charitable organization.
- **Convention Site 2000:** Bowling Green Kentucky may be the site of the year 2000 convention.
- **Governor Meeting Site:** We will be voting in May on the location of the Governor meetings for '98, '99 & 2000. Sites are, Louisville, Indianapolis and St. Louis
- **FCOA:** There has been a renewed interest in the *"Future Corvette Owners Association."* This is an opportunity for youngsters up to the age of 16 to become involved in the future of our organizations, it only costs \$5.00 to sign them up. They get goodies - membership certificate, just to name a few things. They are our future, sign them up! Form attached. Additionally there is a new book out - the *"CORVETTE BOOK FOR KIDS."* Lots of good stuff for kids of all ages. Order form attached - I'll have a sample in May.

Jack and Diane purchased their first (1984) Corvette in 1990. They joined the Capital City Corvette Club in 1990 and they now own a 1995 Corvette.

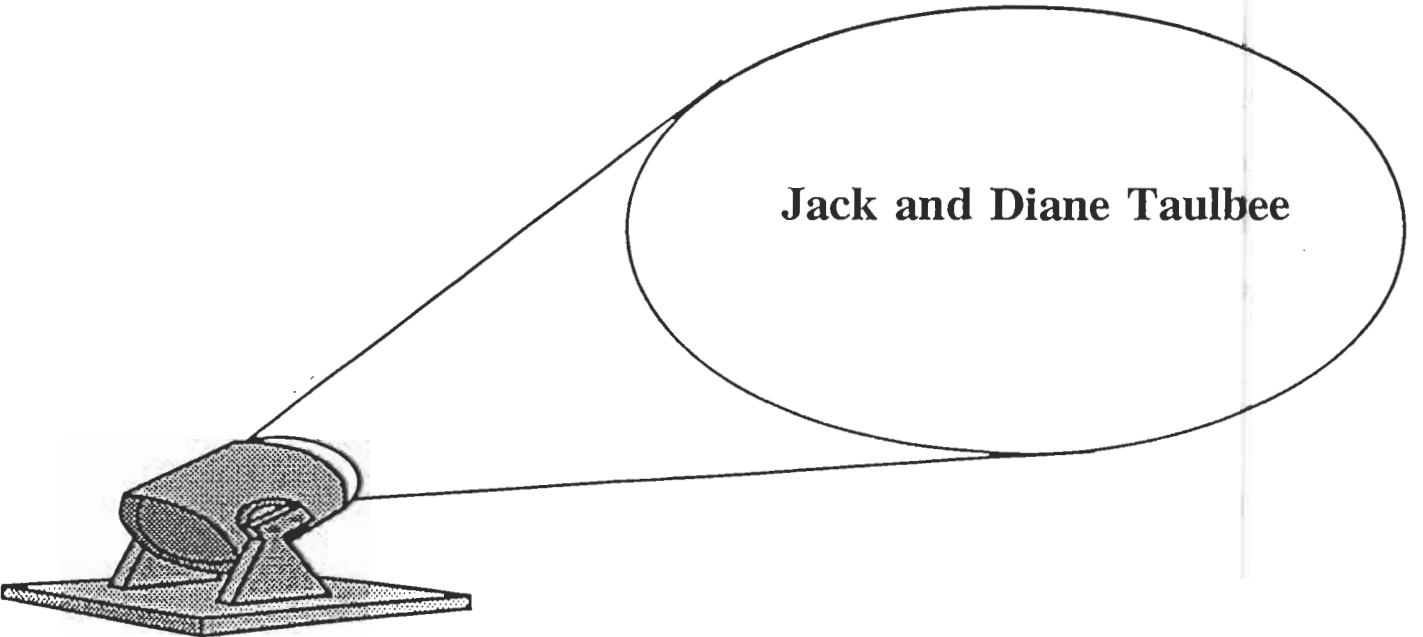
Jack and Diane have been married for 16 years. They have four children, seven grand children, and two great grandchildren. They live in the town of Pleasant Lake.
