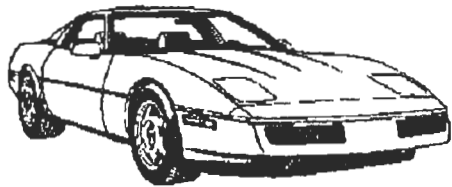

Dick and Pat Hartman are new members of the Capital City Corvette Club. They have a black 1987 coupe, and have owned the car for three years.

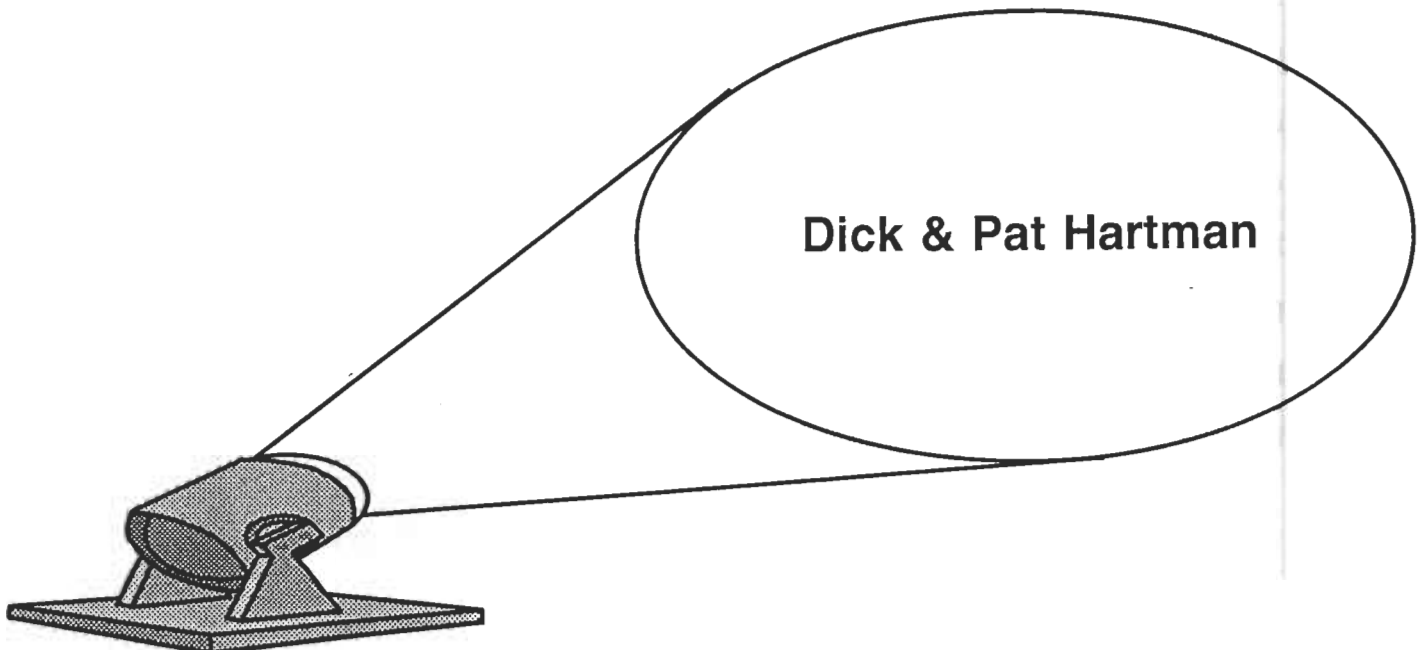
They have been married for 33 years and live in the Delta-Waverly area. They have two children; a daughter who is 25 years old, and a son who is 22.

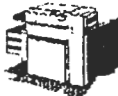
Pat is employed with the Attorney General's office for the State of Michigan, and has worked for the office for ten years. She enjoys bowling, going to the spa, and the Corvette.
