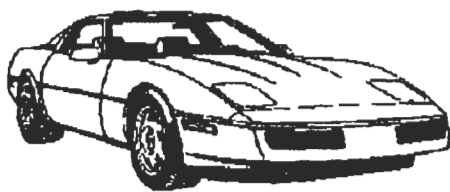

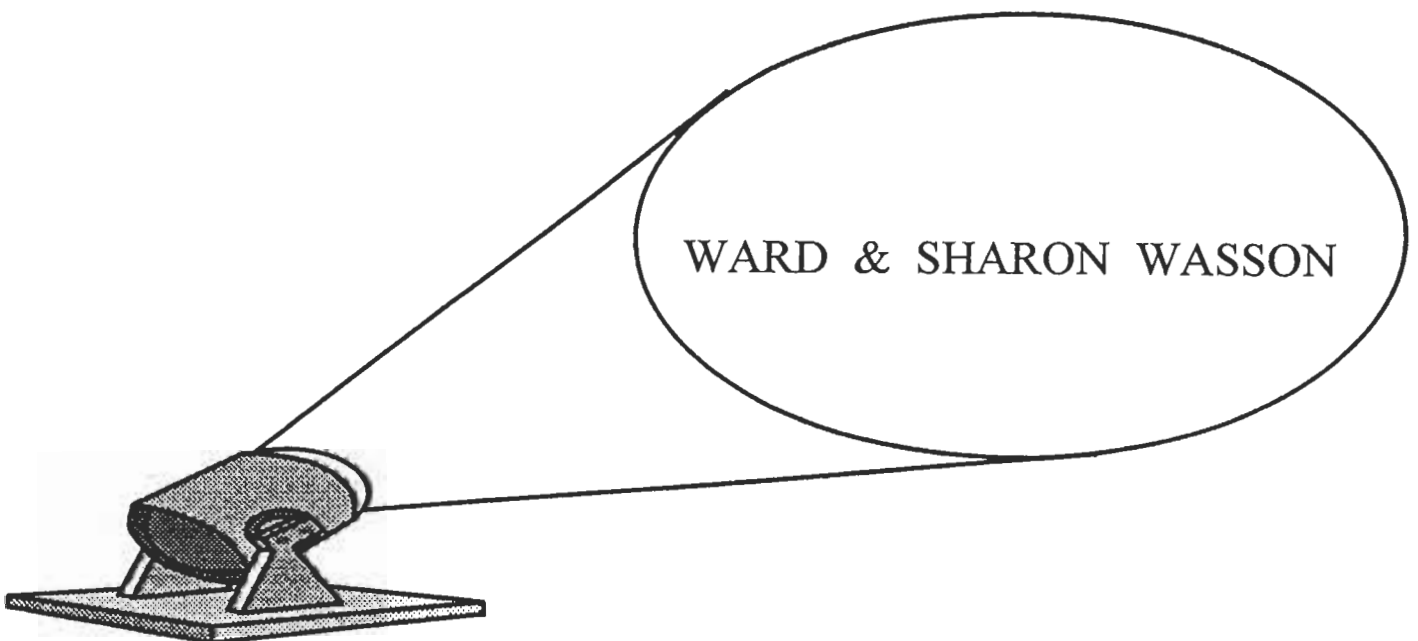
SPOTLIGHT ON OUR MEMBERS
