

## TREASURER'S REPORT

Money collected from raffle tickets should be turned in as soon as possible, because the Corvette to be given away at Convention has been ordered and will need to be paid for upon delivery.

It was reported that as new editor, Loretta Spinrad saved \$3,000 on the first issue of Blue Bars.

# COMPETITION

Record drags scheduled to be held in Michigan in September has been canceled.

Rule changes are as follows: For Group I, replacement exhaust systems are allowed as long as the tubing is equal in size to that of factory exhaust. Gaged exhaust is **not** allowed. BF Goodrich G Force tires are not allowed for Group II. The proposed wheel-to-wheel racing wasn't approved by National because it would not benefit a majority of the NCCC membership.

## **MEMBERSHIP**

There are currently 12,496 National members. There were 13,100 last year. The Membership Director stated that the goal for this year is 13,001.

Future Corvette Owners (FCO) has 578 members. This is approximately a 50% increase in FCO membership.

## CORVETTE MUSEUM

The Diner will be at the Corvette Museum, located in Bowling Green, Kentucky, until June, 1998.

# BUSINESS MANAGER REPORT

In regards to K&K Insurance, there has been only one minor incident this year compared with two or three at this time last year. The Governors were reminded that if an incident happens at any event, fill out an incident report form. There is still no web page for NCCC, but it is still being worked on.

The next Governor's meeting will be in Bowling Green, Kentucky (September). The cost will be \$5.00 per person for group rates for touring the museum. There are no plans for a factory tour on Saturday, but tours are held on Fridays from 9:00 a.m. until 1:00 p.m.

#### **CHARITY**

The raffle car ordered is red, with a black convertible top, and black interior. It is due for delivery in June or July, and the winner will be drawn at convention. The 100% clubs are a little slow coming in this year, so buy your raffle tickets soon.

The Michigan Region donated \$500 to the scholarship fund. (There were 9 scholarship applications received by the May 1 cut-off date).

The charity committee needs help at convention, both at the hotel and at convention booths. People who help will receive extra benefits, such as an umbrella, hats, and lunch. Convention '98 (St. Louis, MO) will feature plenty of entertainment, with lots to do and see. Wednesday night will be a free night so people can go out on the town. There will be a costume party Thursday night, with the costume theme being from the TV series M\*A\*S\*H.

#### BLOOMINGTON GOLD - CAR DRAWING OUTCOME

Due to lack of funds from Bloomington promoters, the 1998 Corvette was not given away. In October, an auction of assets was held and the new owners were given an opportunity to pay for the car for the winner. They elected not to do so, but with the help of a couple people in Missouri, NCCC will receive a 1998 Corvette for the giveaway, courtesy of Route 66, Chevrolet Motor Company and other sponsors.


# SPOTLIGHT ON OUR MEMBERS


CHRIS IS EMPLOYED WITH THE STATE OF MICHIGAN,
