I have started making reservations for the Musuem Caravan in September. I have blocked rooms in Louisville for September 2. I am still researching hotels for the remainder of our stay.


As I said, we have a lot on our plate this year so be prepared to have a great summer. What more could one ask for than having fun with our Corvettes.
