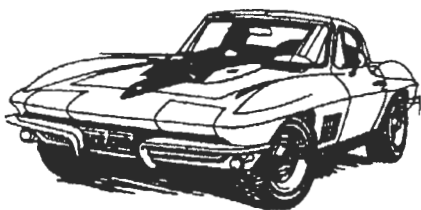

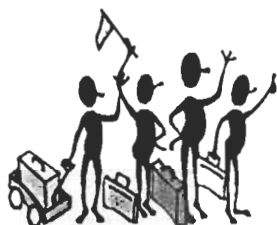

C.C.C.C. GENERAL MEMBERSHIP MEETING MINUTES
2-2-2000

The January minutes were accepted as printed.

PRESIDENT: The National Corvette Museum has asked us for more inserts to the Convention flyer. The car show has been moved from April 30th to April 29th at Holt Auto Sales. At the Governor's Meeting on February 26th in Louisville, some club members are going to sell shirts. Non-Corvette stuff will be sold as well. Steve Spinrad has agreed to let the Club use one table to promote Convention. Ken David has blocked rooms at the Hyatt Regency hotel in Chicago at \$139/night. Some will be leaving for Chicago on Friday at 2:00 p.m. to set up by 9:00 p.m. The Saturday night social will be planned to promote NCCC. Many ideas and suggestions were discussed. Club shirts will be here before Governor's Meeting. The 2001 Convention will be in Bowling Green, Kentucky, the last week in June. We will have a Convention Planning Meeting February 12th at the Old Town Diner then leave for dinner at 6:30 p.m. We will be stuffing envelopes at the meeting. Route 66 is offering us a free spot June 8-11 between Chevy and Mid-America, some free tickets to the show, etc. at Joliet, Illinois (40 miles south of Chicago). We will not put this on our calendar yet. We will wait to see how registrations go.

CONVENTION: We had 20 registrations by the end of December for Convention. Loretta has been getting several calls and e-mails about Convention. Charter fishing is being planned for Charlevoix.
