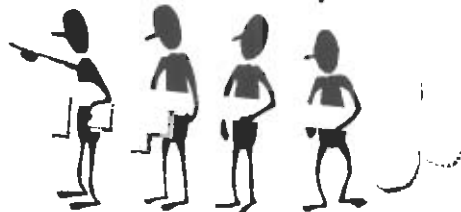

TREASURER: A financial report was given. Bills are paid up. Shirts are available.

PRESIDENT: The Convention Planning Meeting is scheduled for April 15th. There will be a Mystery Dinner afterwards. There is no road in front of the diner so park at the church on the corner or at the counseling center across from the Bait & Tackle shop. Memorial Day Weekend - Make your own reservations, and mention CCCC "only for Memorial Day Weekend". Make sure they know it's not for Convention in July. A club on the east coast (New Jersey) wants to join National Council as a result of our mailing.

CONVENTION: We have 268 registrations in for Convention so far. Donations from Chevy, Firestone, BF Goodrich, and Jack Cauley Chevrolet have been received. There are 12 children currently signed up for the children's program. We have got a few responses from our requests for advertising for convention. Day Passes for Sunday are \$35 to NCCC and sponsored guests. In the Casino package, you get a T-shirt, the car show, food, and entertainment. For those without a car, a shuttle to the casino will be provided. At the Driver's Meeting, the chair people need to tell exactly what is going to happen in their event. We are looking at the high school in Bellaire for a possible starting point. Monday, the kids are going to Pirate's Cove and a campfire at night. They might go to Interlochen one night, the sand dunes another night, and swimming and games one day at Schuss Mountain. As of April 1st, the registration prices have gone up for Convention.
