

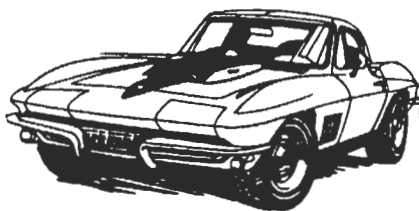

CCCC GENERAL MEMEBERSHIP MEETING

5-3-2000

PRESIDENT: Ask for a newsletter if you did not get one. They were not mailed out. Loretta and Steve are going to Shanty Creek to meet with the State Police and other meetings at the hotel. Governor's Meeting is May 13th in Louisville. It's our last chance to sell shirts at a Governor's Meeting before Convention. We can sell them again at Charlton Park. Blue Bars is being printed now. We will have a 4-page article in it. The trip to Chicago did generate some people that are going to Convention.

COMPETITION: The Drag Races will be held in Stanton on May 20th. Most people are going to race and not work. We need a lot of cooperation from everyone, as we have not ran the drags before. We need people to work Registration, Staging, Tech, and people in the Tower. Spectators have to pay, including workers. The track costs \$1,650 plus trophies. Cost to run the drags in non-Corvettes are \$25 per event and \$4 for spectators and workers. Corvettes are \$30 per event or \$75 for all three events. Helmets are required. Metal body cars are allowed. We need to be there at 8:00 a.m. Registration opens at 8:30 a.m. We will advertise in the Lansing State Journal. Those going can meet at the Lansing Factory Outlet Mall at 6:30 a.m.

SOCIAL: The Car Show held at Holt Auto Sales brought 47 Corvettes. However, only 26 registered. We were able to donate-\$168.35 to the National Kidney Foundation. For Convention, we will have to discuss how to take donations. We can give the sign for the windows out in their packet or when they are lining up. If they don't have it, they can't participate.

The next Car Show will be held at Charlton Park on May 21st. It will also be a People's Choice Councours. Meet at 8:30 a.m. at Don's Truckstop if you plan on caravanning with the group. The Reiffers will lead the group.

There is no interest in going to the 4th of July Parade in Mason.

CONVENTION: We will be meeting at Meijers on Lake Lansing Road at 8:00 a.m. on May 27th for the trip to Shanty Creek over the weekend. This will be our last visit to the resort before Convention. We will meet around 11:30 a.m. – 11:45 in downtown Bellaire for lunch on Saturday.

Our goal for the Car Show is to collect money for the National Kidney Foundation. Corvette Central and Mid-America will send door prizes. Someone else sent a \$100 gift certificate. We have started buying door prizes. Everyone please look for possible door prizes for men and women.

Currently, there are 316 people registered now. We need to get more sponsors to cover the cost of the events. There are currently 14 children in the Youth Program.

TREASURER: A financial report was given on shirt sales and our account balance. We are hoping to sell a bunch more shirts at Charlton Park.

MEMBERSHIP: We currently have 53 members.

GOVERNOR: Raffle tickets are for sale to win the Corvette.

PUBLIC RELATIONS: Steve talked to Steve Hanks about our Car Show and our ad in the newsletter for Holt Auto. Hanks is happy about selling two cars that day. Loretta will send him a thank you letter.
