NATIONAL NEWS RESULTS

Please be aware of the due dates on the schedule for your paperwork!!

Results should be TYPED – the handwritten results are almost illegible by the time they are copied and sent in to National and Roger does not want to decipher them. Non-NCCC entrants should not appear on the results.

Event chairman that also enter the event should declare at the driver's meeting if they are running for event points or chairman points. Then they should only appear in one place on the results – either in their class or as chairman.

POINTS

National Points are being posted on the web. However, they are only as current as the paperwork from the RCD's. In the past, points standing were done 4 times per year and were only as current as the paperwork from the RCD's. The web points have the same shortcomings as the old way, only now it's done more often!! Most event points are 30 days (or more) behind. DO NOT call Laurie or Roger about the points on the web. If you have questions or corrections, contact the event chairman first, who should call the governor, who should contact the RCD and I will contact National if needed. This is the necessary chain of command. DO NOT call Roger in Texas.

As an aside, the regional points are now on the Michigan Region link at www.corvettesnccc.org. If you are receiving a copy of the points with this letter, then I do not have an email address for you. If you want to receive points updates by email instead, send me your address at the above address.

High Speed Certification – all existing cardholders are grandfathered until January 1, 2003.

Questions raised at the July meeting:

1. Can a club's declared city be located in another region – yes. This is a membership issue, not a competition issue.
2. If a car is mis-teched and runs in a class on Saturday, and then is found to be illegal for that class on the next day, should the class/points from Saturday stand? In the opinion of the RCD's – Yes, Saturday's event should not be changed. However, if a competitor knowingly runs in the wrong class, this is considered unsportsmanlike conduct.
3. New Classification – 2001 Z06 Hardtop – will run in Group 1-Street H, or Group I H, depending on the tires.
