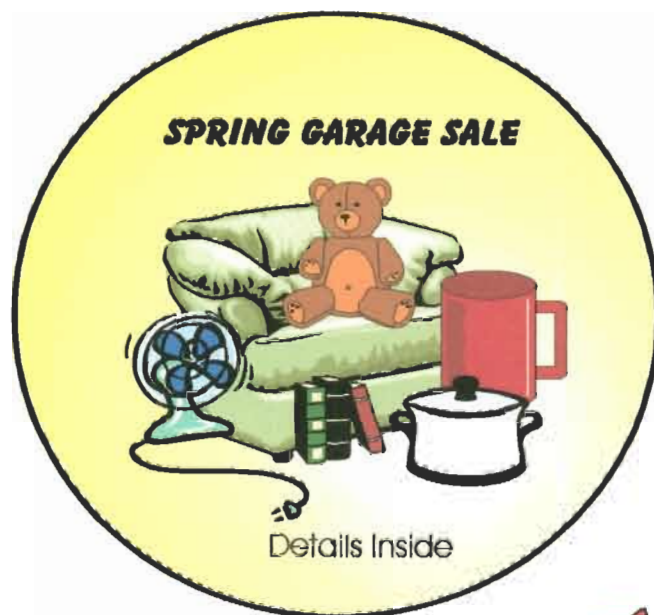

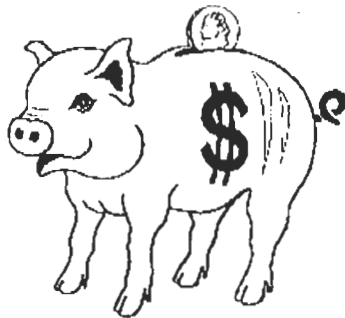
PLEASE NOTE:

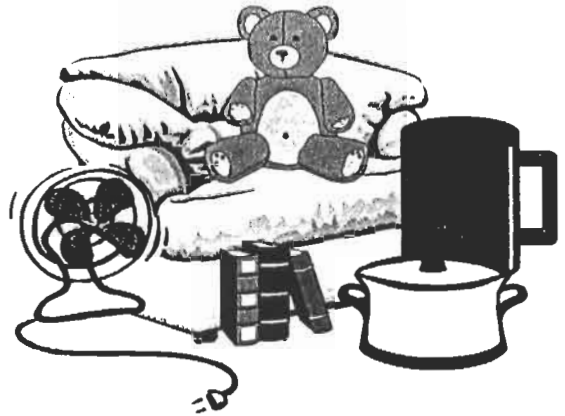

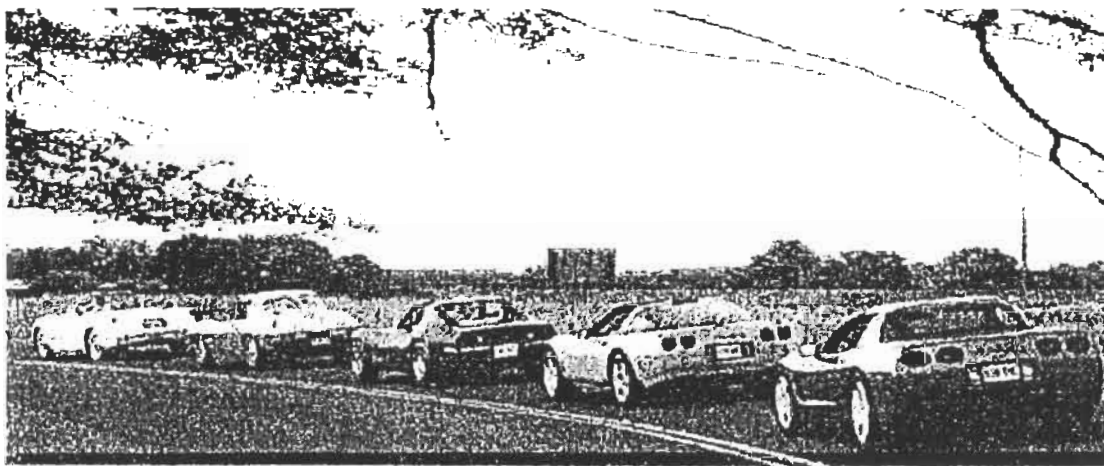

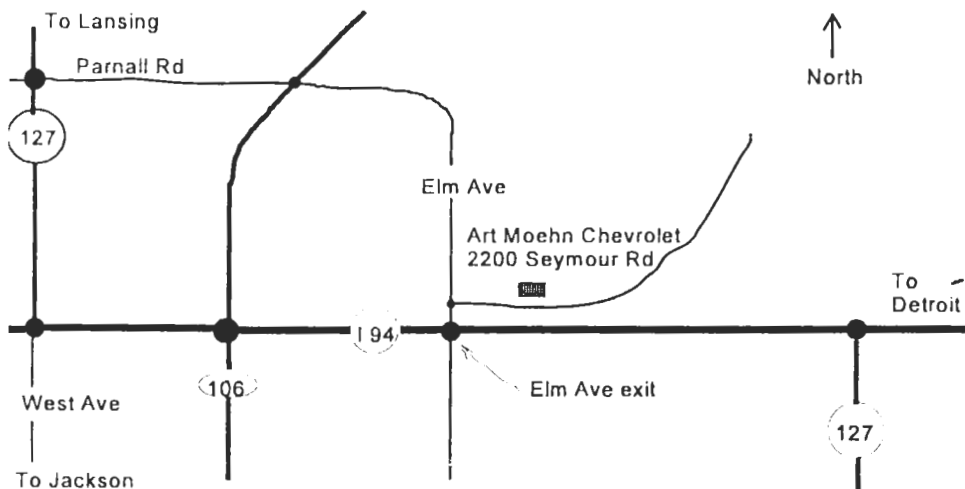
