Windsor Mountain Grille is located at 6951 Lansing Road, near the corner of Canal Road.

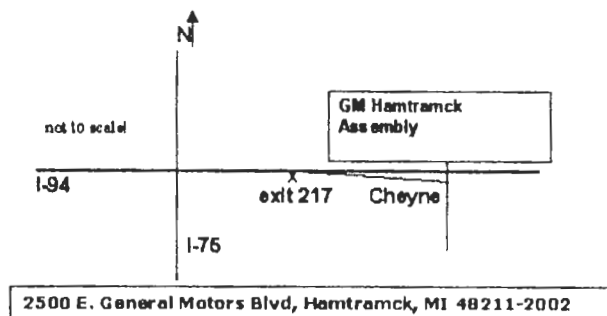
