SECRETARY: Copy of the January general membership meeting and board meeting minutes are in the newsletter.

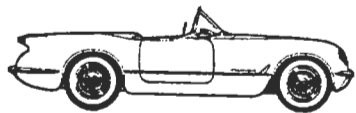

WHAT IS FCOA?

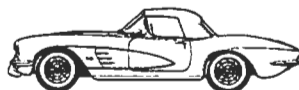

FCOA started in 1991 as an effort to instill and then maintain an interest in the Corvette hobby within the younger generation.

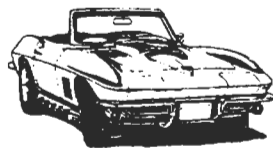


WHAT DO FCOA KIDS GET?

By creating excitement about our favorite car, hopefully FCOA members will go on to be active NCCC members. This is the generation that is the Corvette enthusiast of NCCC's future!

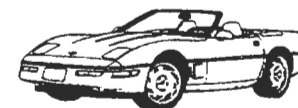


WHO CAN JOIN FCOA?

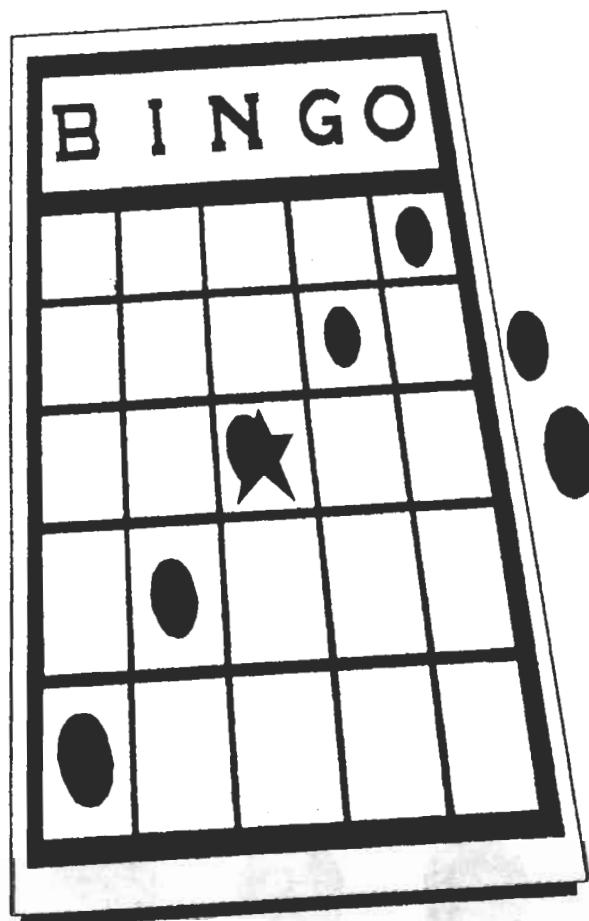

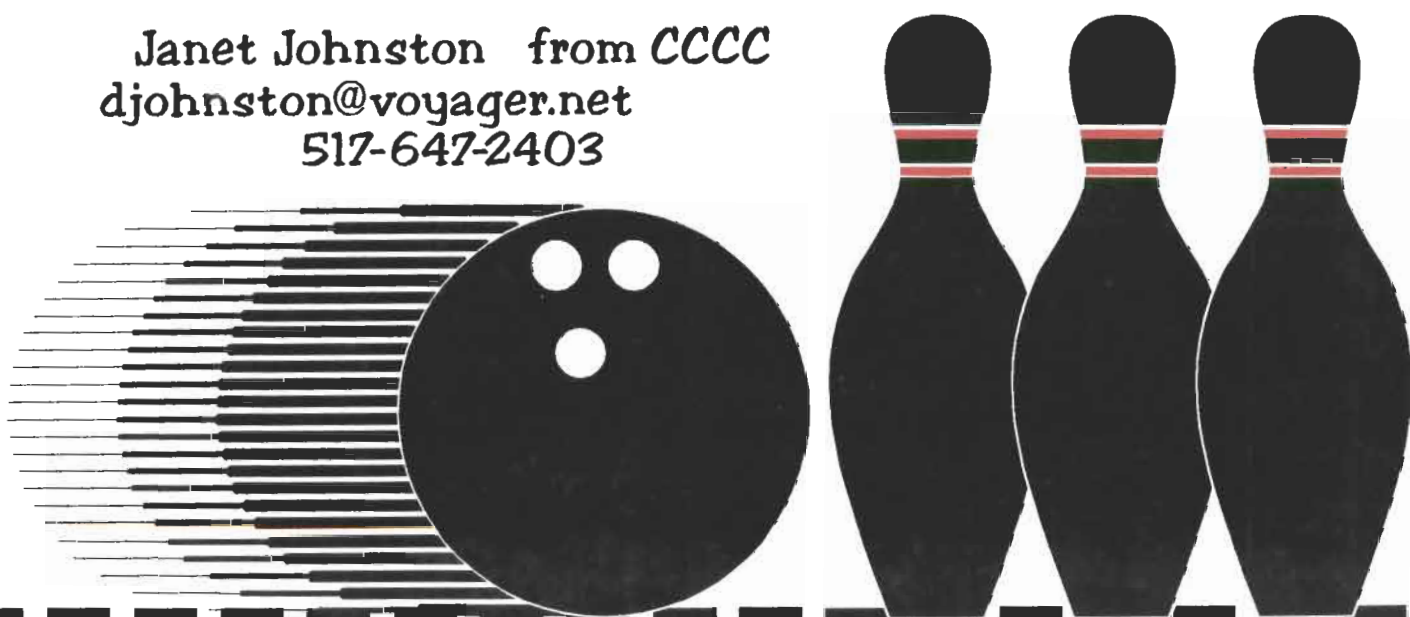

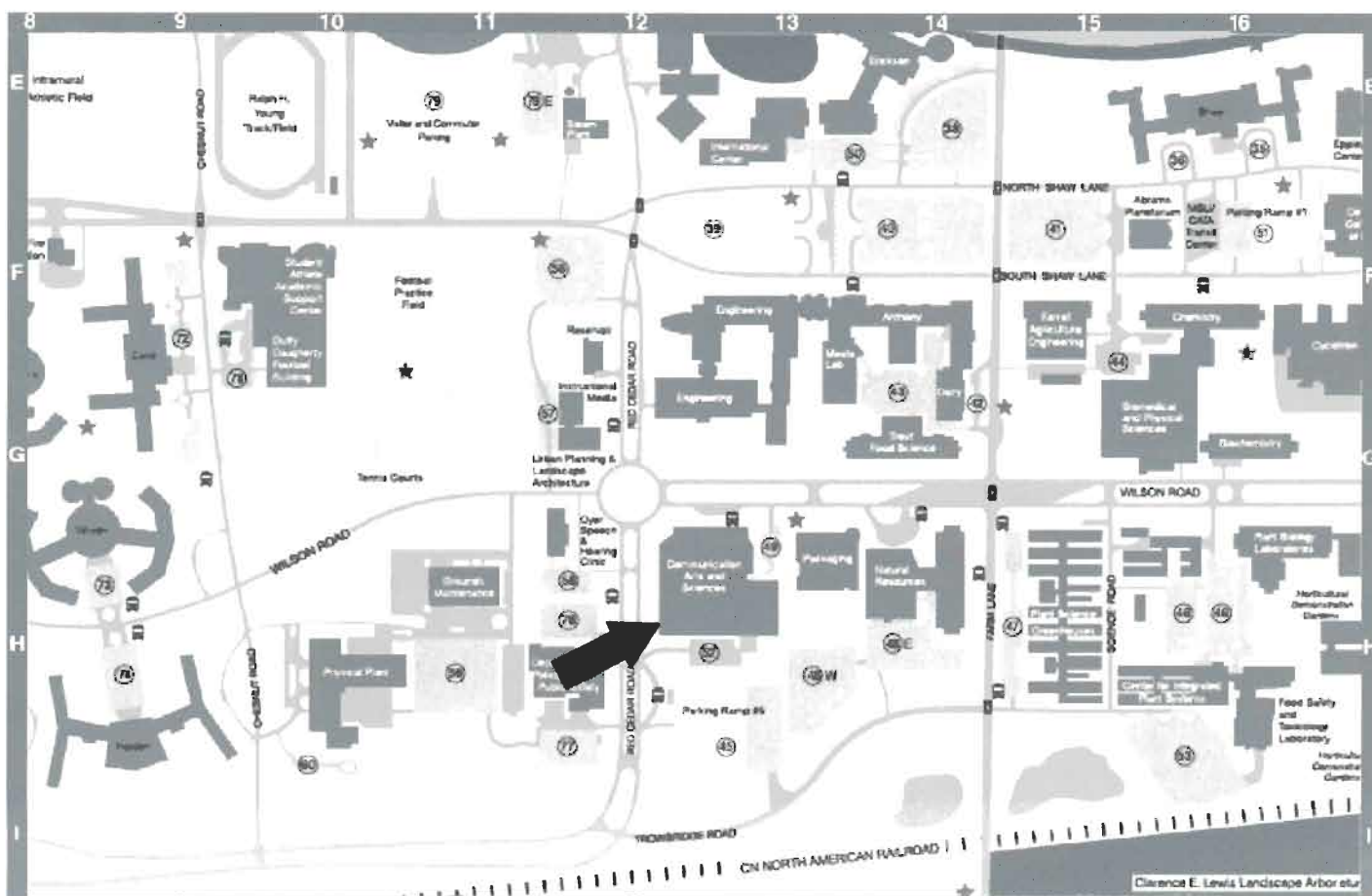
