CCCC BOARD MEETING MINUTES 10/15/03

SECRETARY: No report.

PUBLIC RELATIONS: No report.

<u>MEMBERSHIP</u>: As of tonight, membership remains at 92 adults, with 40 paid renewals. Name badges will be ordered for all new members. In the meantime, we can either have a temporary button made for \$1.00 or purchase a few blank badges and use Simon and Gloria's label maker as a temporary. Any member interested is eligible to purchase a lifetime membership with NCCC. Current cost is \$320.00. That would reduce your annual local club dues to \$35.00.

<u>SOCIAL</u>: The hayride was a great success. I think everyone enjoyed the evening. The Color Tour also very successful; 25 cars participated. The weather was absolutely perfect. Upcoming events: Mexican Train Nov. 1st, Bingo at Tamarack Nov. 8th, Christmas Dinner Dec. 3rd., and the Annual Banquet January 24th. Reservations have been made at Mountain Jacks. Cost will be \$25.00 per person, including tip.

<u>POINTS</u>: Don distributed copies of the current points program. He had some revision suggestions for next year (i.e., eliminate points for Board Members, region events, etc.). After a lengthy discussion, Phil suggested he form a committee from the membership to review and then present a committee recommendation.

TREASURER: All payables have been paid. There are 27 remaining zoo shirts which the zoo agreed to purchase at cost and resell in their gift shop. Motion was made and approved, selling remaining shirts to the zoo for \$126. Phil opened an account with 6 months free interest at CompUSA when he purchased the copier. He offered to have the club pay him back monthly. The board felt it would be better since we were near year-end and change in officers near to pay the bill in full. Motion unanimously passed, and the treasurer will issue check upon receipt of bills. It was also noted there are only enough newsletter covers for one more mailing. Phil suggested we put our sponsor, Pres Kool's, ad on the back cover. He and Jeff would get quotes for printing/folding costs.

<u>COMPETITION</u>: Calendar with 2004 event dates was distributed. Spartan Speedway cost expected to increase this year to \$350 or more. Other possibility would be holding the low speed event at the State Police Test Track. This would be a first choice option and will be researched further. Also for consideration, renting as a group or with another club, a drag strip for the day...just for fun. Bids for sanctioned event dates will be at the November Region Meeting. Dates chosen by the Board were: Pres Kool car show: 1st choice June 19th, 2nd choice May 22nd, Low Speeds first choice July 17th, 2nd choice July 10th or 24th.

GOVERNOR: No report.

<u>PRESIDENT</u>: Club Federal Tax ID and Tax Exempt status was discussed. Ideas for vendor control regarding club apparel and future options were discussed. No final determinations made and will continue discussion / ideas at a later date.

<u>NEW BUSINESS</u>: Phil suggested the club purchase an Adobe Acrobat program. This could be used for printing awards and greatly increase newsletter capabilities. Motion made and passed unanimously.
