TREASURER: Current activity and account balances were reported.

MEMBERSHIP: Current membership total; Adult - 98, FOCC - 31. Club brochures have been updated with new meeting location, and can be picked up after the meeting from Evelyn.

Volunteers are needed to help with food, door prizes, registration, etc. Greg will circulate a sign up sheet at the next general meeting. 150 flyers were distributed at the Carlton Park show. Phil's report; Simon & Gloria are making final arrangements for the road rally. Low speeds at the GM plant are no longer an option; they will be at Spartan again this year. The board discussed whether to continue with the picnic after the low speeds, consensus; agreed do to the amount of planning required, we will opt to make arrangements at a local restaurant for dinner instead. Still need a chairman for this event. Working on Horsepower at the Zoo. Suggested flyer read: 'must be present to win door prizes.'

COMPETITION REPORT

June, 2004

Competition events in June are few because of the NCCC Convention in Las Vegas from the 5th through the 11th. After that, we get back into it beginning with our Corvette Show and Rallye at Pres Kool Chevrolet on Saturday, June 19th. For those of you who attended the Rallye School, it will be a great time to show what you've learned. Hopefully we'll have great weather and a great turnout.

On Sunday, June 20th, the Corvette Club of Michigan, the North Oaks Corvette Club, and the Huron Valley Corvette Club join together to host five Low Speed events in Detroit at the GM Hamtramack Assembly plant. If you pre-register for these events by June 12th, you'll save a few bucks.

The following Sunday, the 27th, the Kalamazoo Corvette Club is holding two Low Speeds and a Matching Time Trial at Harper Creek High School in Battle Creek.

The weekend of July 10th and 11th is a huge weekend of competition events at Gingerman Raceway in South Haven. This won't be your typical "racers only" event. Each day there is a Peoples Choice Corvette Show, two Low Speed, two Matching Time Trial, and two High Speed events. For those who are only interested in the car shows, an added bonus is that you get to do some parade laps on the track. There are substantial savings if you pre-register before June 30th. This event will draw Corvettes from all over the Midwest and beyond. I'm sure it will be a great time.

If you have an interest in driving your Corvette competitively but aren't too sure about driving on a race track, the June 20th and 27th events are a great opportunity give it a try. Both of these events are being held in parking lots where about the only thing to hit is a pylon. Believe me, I've hit my share and they don't hurt the car a bit!

A reminder to all of you: Don't forget to take your NCCC membership card with you to all events. Your membership number is required for you and our club to receive points for your participation. Also, many events are now offering a discounted entry fee for NCCC members, including our car show and rallye, but only if you have proof of membership. It's to your benefit to carry your NCCC card with you.
