COMPETITION REPORT

HELP! PLEASE HELP!

It's that time of year again. We'll be hosting our annual autocross events again this year at Spartan Speedway on Saturday, July 24th. It takes a lot of help to make this day successful. We will need people to help set up the course and timing equipment beginning around 8:00 AM. We need people to help out at registration which runs from 9:00 AM to 10:00 AM, but we will need to be set up and ready to go beginning at 8:30 AM. There will be five separate events beginning at 10:30 AM with each taking about an hour to an hour and a quarter to complete with a lunch break after the second event. People will be needed for timing, scoreboard, staging, starting, and corner workers during the events. Any help you can give will be very much appreciated. You need not be at the track all day if you have other commitments. Even a couple hours of your time will be great. I will talk more about the jobs available and pass around a sign-up sheet at the July 7th meeting.

As for other competition events going on in July, the Corvette Summer events take place at Gingerman Raceway near South Haven on the 10th and 11th with the opportunity for some test and tune track time on the 9th. This will be another big weekend with a car show, matching times, low speed, and high speed events on Saturday and Sunday.

On the 17th and 18th, the Flint Corvette Club is hosting three low speeds on Saturday and two on Sunday in Flint.

On Sunday the 25th, the Shiawassee Corvette Club is hosting five low speed events at Owosso Speedway.

If you love Corvette shows, and I know a lot of you do, then Michigan International Speedway is the place to be on the 31st, and August 1st. For one low price you can enter the car shows and get two grandstand tickets to the racing each day. Saturday has the NASCAR Craftsman Truck Race as well as practice for Sunday's races. Sunday has the Infinity Pro Series race and the IRL Indycar Series race. If you've ever been to a NASCAR race, those cars will seem slow compared to the Indy cars zooming around at 230 mph! Get your registration in by June 30th to save yourself \$10.
