AUGUST 4, 2004

President Simon Reiffer called the meeting to order at 7:05 p.m., Delhi Café, Holt.

Officers' Reports:

SECRETARY: Absent. Minutes from July's General Meeting are in the Newsletter. No corrections, minutes approved.

PUBLIC RELATIONS: John Bechtel had nothing to report.

POINTS: Don Armstrong stated current points are on the website.

TREASURER: Absent. President Reiffer reported account balances.

MEMBERSHIP: Evelyn Aronson welcomed tonight's new members and guests. Membership totals: 123 Adult, 32 FOCC. Evelyn reminded members that club brochures are available to pass out.

SOCIAL: Janet Johnston provided information on upcoming events: Lake Odessa Summer Splash Car Show 9:00 a.m. August 7th, BBQ at Pam Thompson's following show. Corvette Crossroads, Mackinaw City, August 27-29. Hayride/Bonfire/Dominoes at the Hutton's on September 11th. Fall Color Tour hosted by the Armstrong's on October 9th. Janet acknowledged Kurt Schwamberger's recent "Best of Show" for his Mallett at the Black Hills Classic in South Dakota. Janet acknowledged members with August birthdays. She noted a Red Hat weekend at Crystal Lake on August 21st.

EDITOR: Carol Armstrong indicated newsletter deadline is August 20th.

COMPETITION: Phil Hanes reported that our low speed event at Spartan Speedway was a success, and he thanked everyone who worked/participated. Several regional competition events are coming up. Check the newsletter and website for dates and times.

Kurt & Sharon Schwamberger suggested we consider attending the Black Hills Classic Corvette show next July. They indicated the show was wonderful and the 400-mile trip offered beautiful scenery. CCCC BOARD MEETING

August 18, 2004

SECRETARY: Nothing new to report.

PUBLIC RELATIONS: RE; Horsepower at the Zoo, notices have been sent to local TV & Radio Stations. Weekly notices will continue to be sent, along with info to local newspapers. Per Simon, \$2100.00 has been collected so far from sponsors. We are still in need of door prizes and items for goodie bags. Gloria has volunteered to stuff them, if you can help, contact her direct. Phil reported quoted prices for awards and dash plaques. 'Teal' will be the award color this year. T-Shirts will be ordered two weeks prior to the show. We will also order one for 'sponsors' if they have requested. The board discussed DJ options. Jeff McQuade volunteered to contact last years DJ and will also contact Carol at the Zoo to make final arrangements. John also noted he had responded to a club email from Owosso requesting repair advise. He then received a reply of appreciation and a request to join the club.

POINTS: Don is in the process of verifying NCCC points via their website. He suggested we review the point program again prior to year-end.

TREASURER: Pending invoices were reviewed. Don Armstrong made a motion to approve for payments, 2nd John Bechtel.

MEMBERSHIP: Current membership 127, youth 40. Evelyn made a motion that the website application address be changed to the current Membership Directors, rather than the PO Box (address on the brochures would remain the same). This would allow her to expedite new applications, and have member packets ready at the next meeting. Motion 2nd Don Armstrong. Board unanimous. Evelyn had also received a 'member suggestion' to circulate a club survey. Objective; possibly offer more variety in club events (mystery dinners, cruises, etc), basically to assure there is something for everyone. Board agreed this was a good idea. Evelyn will contact the member and request preparation of a rough draft for approval at the next board meeting. Simon noted NCCC dues will be increasing by \$5.00 this September. Board unanimously agreed to reduce our club dues by \$5.00, which would keep membership fee the same for next year. Also, FYI there are 17,468 National Members and 293 Clubs.

GOVERNOR: Michigan Region Meeting September 7th, NCCC Governors Meeting September 18th.

PRESIDENT: Miller Farms have offered to let us host a car show in their area next year. They would provide space, food etc. Any profits made could be donated to a charity of our choice. Board discussion determined we would like to keep this option open and discuss further at a later date. While Bob was on vacation, it came to Simon's attention; there is only one key for the club mailbox. Motion was made by Don Armstrong to purchase a second key and allow access not only to the Club Treasurer, but also the Club President. 2nd Janet Johnston.

OLD BUSINESS: John B.; At Spartan Low Speeds the Tech Crew noted some discrepancies in passing inspection and did not feel this should be allowed. It was agreed to discuss in detail with Renee for clarification to eliminate this problem in the future.
