EDITOR: Newsletter deadline is May 23.


GOVERNOR: Region asked for an updated list of members from Evelyn.

Notice of By-Laws Change Petition

The CCCC Board of Directors received a petition, signed by 10 members, to add the position of National Corvette Museum Ambassador to the CCCC By-Laws. A vote will be taken on this addition during the July 6 General Membership Meeting. The addition is as follows:


ARTICLE V - SECTION B

The following positions shall be appointed annually by the President with the approval of the Board of Directors and shall serve at the discretion of the President and the Board. The appointed Officers shall have no vote, but may provide input to the Board on matters before it.

Duties of the National Corvette Museum Ambassador – The NCM Ambassador shall perform such duties as shall be designated by the Board of Directors. This Member shall be responsible for complying with any and all requirements set forth by the NCM with regards to the Ambassador position and shall be responsible for maintaining communication between the Club and the NCM, reporting such information to Members quarterly in the Club newsletter. This Member shall represent the Club at certain NCM functions, foster participation by Club Members in NCM activities, and assist Club Members with any questions they have on NCM matters.
