
Terry has a 1993 black Corvette coupe that he has owned since the fall of 2003. Cyndy has a 2000 VW Turbo Beetle; that is her baby.

# 1<sup>st</sup> Annual Blessing of the Vettes

We were thinking the club needed something it could do every year and thought this was exactly what we were looking for, a show that could grow and become as popular as the Corvette Celebration held annually in May at Charlton Park. I know some of you have heard of the "Blessing of the Bikes" held annually in Baldwin. That draws thousands of bikers from all over the state of Michigan. Now you know where the idea came from.

The more I thought about this the better it sounded. I questioned "Chappy (Gary Wyma)" about the idea to see what his thoughts and feelings were toward to blessing our beloved Corvettes. He thought it was a good idea, so I talked to other club members for their opinions about a car show where we would have our Corvettes blessed. The response was positive and from that point on the wheels began to turn.

All last summer Diana and I were thinking about where to hold this event but couldn't think of a place. Then we went to the cruise-in at Culver's. We had a great time there. We mentioned the idea of a "Blessing of the Vettes" car show to Cory Chvala, owner/operator, of Culver's. Cory thought it was a good idea and offered his place of business for the 1<sup>st</sup> Annual Blessing of the Vettes. This was great. We now have a place to hold our car show, all we needed was a date. We knew we wanted it to take place before Memorial Day and hopefully before the graduation open houses started. After looking at the calendar, we chose the Saturday before Memorial Day for our first "Blessing".

In our efforts to make this show one people would come back to, we looked at all of the other shows we had been to and what we liked/disliked about each one. We really liked the car show where the pre-registered participants never had to get out of their cars upon arriving at the show. All they had to do was stop, sign the waiver and go park their cars. At other car shows you have to get out of your car, fill out the registration form, sign the waiver form, pick up your goody bag then walk back to your car and find a parking spot. So this is what we did at our show. If you pre-registered all you had to do was stop, sign the wavier form and go park your car, instead of stopping first to go through the registration process. Judging was another area we thought needed some attention. We didn't want our club to get the reputation that "club cars" get the majority of the awards. So we had our first experience with separate judging for "host" cars.

Diana and I feel that next years' show will be the true measure of success. We had 49 cars entered in the show, plus 7 who just wanted the Blessing. We had 5 Michigan Corvette Clubs represented, 1 Wisconsin club that brought 8 cars, and 2 cars from Canada. We looked at the rain at the end of the show as a sign that our show is going to grow. We would like to thank all the club members who worked at the show. You were a valuable asset to the success the CCCC's 1st Annual Blessing of the Vettes.
