"Griff's Golden Rice Salad"

17 April 1999-Raining, bored, decide to cook up a big bowl of potato salad. Only one damn potatoe (Dan Quail spelling) in the house! Got pissed off, used rice! It was a hit! 500 people or more have tried my recipe... All called to say they liked it. So Here:

Ingredients:

¼ cup Wishbone Italian Salad Dressing

½ Teaspoon each: Salt, Black Pepper, Cayenne Pepper

2 Cups "Minute" Premium Long Grain Rice (Add 3 Chicken Bouillon Cubes in Water When Boiling)

1/3 Cup Stuffed Olives (Chop)

2 Hard Boiled Eggs (Chop)

2/3-Cup Celery (Chop)

1/4 Cup Chopped Dill Pickle

1/2 Onion (Chop)-More if you like onions

1/2 Cup Mayonnaise (More if needed...you can tell...adjust)

2 Tablespoons Yellow Mustard

1/2 Cup Green Onions (Tops Only)

Parsley and Paprika to Garnish

Constructions: (I like that... "to put together"...right?)

1. Blend Salad Dressing, salt and pepper
2. Pour over Hot cooked rice in "Suitable" Bowl
3. Add remaining stuff, and mix well. "Adjust" Mayo.
4. Chill covered in Refrig. (I like to eat some "hot".)

Goes good with Ribs, Pork Chops, Fried Fish,...Damn near anything!

From 1993 or along there somewhere. I was watching a TV Cook Show, and this Joker on some Island was "really" screwing up some chicken! I wrote down some of the stuff, had a Martini, laughed, and then went back over it and threw out what I didn't like, had a Martini, added some things I like, had another Martini, and cooked some chicken. Turned out really good, and some friends who came over went wild. They asked for the recipe and I had to do this from memory. (Good thing I have a wonderful memory. A Blessing, or a Curse...sometimes it's a "toss up".)

8 Chicken Thighs-Remove skin, debone, and cut into 1" pieces

Chop 2 large onions-place in a large pot with a lid

Sauté in ¼ inch "Bertolli" Extra Virgin Olive Oil until "Clear"-(Where do you get an "Extra Virgin" ?)

Salt and pepper Chicken, and sprinkle with Cayenne pepper

When onions are "clear" add chicken and cook until tender-stirring often

Add 3 stalks finely chopped celery

Add 3 cups of chicken broth (Make it with bouillon cubes if you'd like to)

Drain, and Add: (1)- 10 ounce Jar of Stuffed Olives

(1)- 2 ounce Jar of Capers

Add (1)-8 ounce Jar Pimentos (water and all)

Bring to a Boil

Reduce heat to "Simmer"-Add 2 ½ Cups "Minute" Rice-Simmer for 5 Minutes covered-

Rice should be cooked by then. (Add more rice if needed-Adjust as you see fit.)

Add (1) 303 Can of "Le Seur" baby green peas-drain, do not add liquid.

Stir and Serve

French Bread, and Cold Chablis Blanc go well with this-Will feed six.

See you all in 2006!

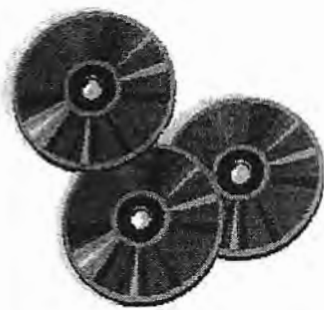

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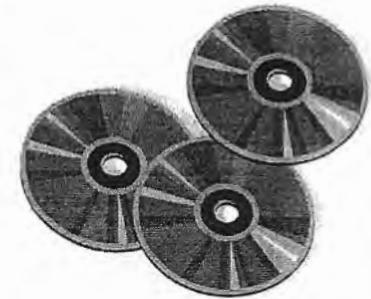


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
