His hobbies include what else.... Vettes !! He also plays a little golf, but mainly just Vettes.

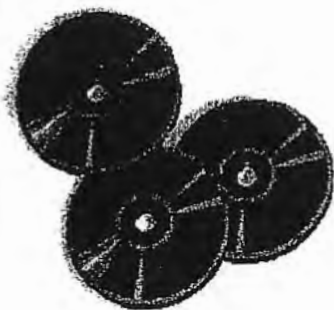

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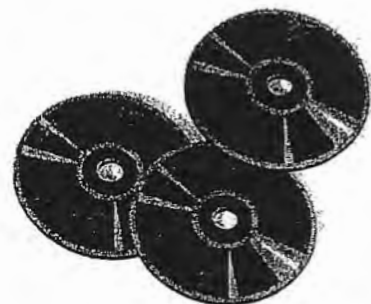


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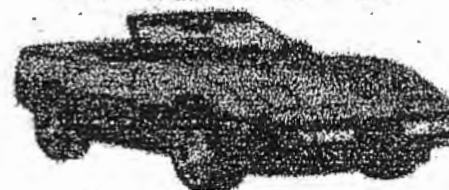
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
