



Be sure to wear your blue club T-shirt. They look great on camera!


Vermontville Maple Syrup Festival Parade





Low Speed Training - April 22

For those interested in participating in a non-sanctioned (and fun) low speed training, the Michigan Region is planning to hold a session in the Marshall area, on April 22. We expect only about 4 or 5 clubs to participate, including CCCC which has been active on the planning committee.

Here is what you need to know:

- 1. This training is for new drivers with no experience or who have not completed more than 6 speed events in the last two years (i.e., novice drivers only).
- 2. The training will be held in a parking lot, using orange cones to mark the course which basically means that even your fastest speed will be less than 25-30 mph.
- 3. Entry fees will be \$40.00 per person for pre-registration, and \$50.00 per person the day of the event.
- 4. The training is limited to the first 25 drivers, with no more than 5 to 6 drivers per instructor.
- 5. Each club is expected to provide at least 5 workers who are not planning to participate in the training.
- 6. This is tentatively planned to be an all day event (likely 9am to 4pm or so) with training and driving in both the morning and afternoon.
- 7. Watch the CCCC website calendar for details, flyer, and registration form.

This training will include a chance to ride with an instructor while being coached on all aspects of low speed driving. As a trainee, you will then drive on the course alone under the observation of the instructor, with feedback provided after your run. An electric timer will be used so that you will be able to see your progress.

This should be a lot of fun as well as a perfect opportunity for those who are interested in trying a low speed event. If you have questions about this training, or just need some encouragement, contact Mark Hansen at (517) 627-3866 or Kurt Schwamberger at (231) 972-7880.
